

## THE NEED OF GREATER PSYCHIC KNOWLEDGE By Alcinous B. Jamison, M.D., F.A.C.P., New York City, N.Y.

HE EVOLUTION of Spirit-man was first prompted by animal instinct, and as that psychophysical mental quality unfolded into greater bodily sensitivity this acquired mental sensitiveness was called intuition, and as intuitionalism evolved, the mind was capable of divining, or ough presentiment or prophesy was able to conjecture, future

joys or sorrows. It was nothing supernatural or marvelous for Godman to prophesy coming events. The exercise of highly unfolded intuition engendered belief, faith, hope, prayer and worship of an indefinable power, called God.

His mind and senses are not sufficiently unfolded to acquaint him with the discarnate beings that so numerously environ him, who were many times incarnated as men. They are kindly beings, willing to help all and hinder none on their divine destiny. They are the intangible, invisible, inaudible power that soothes the bereaved mind, counseling when in need of help those who are dependent upon their intuition only as the guide of their conduct.

Since the advent of the dawn-man upon the earth until the present time a group of humans known as fundamentalists have parked their minds on intuitional mental soil. Their minds were moulded by heredity and environment into ancient phonograph records of belief, faith, hope, prayer and worship, according to the Holy Bible. Ideas held fast in the mind of a person will mentally imprison that person until some psychophysical cataclysm releases the victim from his mental inertia. More or less awakened intuition of Spirit-man causes some of the parked humans to revolt against the ancestral mental parking conditions of the uncultured intuitional soil. In revolting they went volting somewhere with the assurance they were not lost. This group of humans that have evolved beyond the limits of mental instinct and are parking at the outer mental border of the evolved intuitional state of mind, an evolved state of consciousness where the animal mind and senses are nearing a greater unfoldment, and naturally they feel the need of a great "religion." How can a greater religion than already exists be comprehended by the minds of men guided by instinct and intuition only? What can their minds and senses cognize more than quadrupeds do? There is a reason.

What humans most need today is knowledge of psychic science, to know the natural laws of mental action and the unfoldment of mind. Have the group of Fundamentalists and Modernists reached the mental limitation of human enfoldment? They certainly have as long as they choose to be mental dependents and ignore their eternal Godself's creative potency.

We have traced the evolution of mind thus far and will show that further unfoldment of mind and senses can be made only by discarding all ancestral mental rubbish, that by proper or normal thinking and living the psychophysical animal mind and senses will gradually be transformed into a psychological soul that can perceive through its senses the phenomena of the ethereal earth and the discarnate beings that environ God-man. Psychophysical unfoldment of Spirit-man's soul enables him to observe through his soul's senses new territories or extensions of the earth's inhabitable regions that are adaptable to the various grades or groups of spirits while yet unfolding their psychophysical souls to enable them to advance to yet more spiritual ethereal regions of the earth's continuation, attaining the glorious ethereal luminous celestial zone or heaven where the inhabitants know no evil, emancipated psychophysically from all

that pertained to their existence and manifestation on the mundane plane of the earth. This much we are able to inform the reader of his future destiny through the soul's transforming creative efforts which no doubt only marks an epoch in a spirit's potential creative unfoldment beyond our ability at present to cognize.

Psychic science will enable Spirit-man to know his whence and whither. The various human religions have greatly hindered the mental evolution of the human race. Now large groups of teachers feel the need of scientific demonstrable knowledge as a basis for psychophysical evolution of Spirit-man. We realize that knowledge of PSYCHIC SCIENCE in all its bearings is the key that will unlock the basis problem of being and the resulting phenomena of life. Being is not so difficult a problem if approached in a proper manner and patiently continued, as demonstration and realization must follow. It can be approched on the lower conscious plane of being and gradually evolve to the higher planes of consciousness as we have already indicated. Spirit-man functions in a psycho-physical environment that is created by his own mind on the mundane plane of manifestation. He who is wedded to tradition has turned mind against progress. Spirit-man is merely a domesticated being, like an animal, until his spirit-senses are opened, so that he can think rationally.

When Spirit-man's mind and senses are unfolded, he sees God manifested in every living thing and is a nature lover.

# SOWING AND REAPING

ERE and hereafter we shall reap what we sow. Heaven or hell is the harvest; the growing crops, so to speak, we have cultivated and cared for through life. God does not punish or reward, but people punish or reward themselves as they have accomplished good or evil. Anything at variance with the code of conduct embodied in the teachings of Jesus or in the Ten Commandments is an evil and can be naught else. Anyone who at any time violates this law will have to pay the penalty. As individuals live they build a character good or bad which will attract to them a corresponding destiny.

A spirituality and spiritual conception implies a love of God and man and a due regard for the rights of others.

AVE the small candles lighted and in place. Open with the following prayer: Masters of LIGHT and TRUTH, help me

to rise to the heights of spiritual understanding, that I may absorb this evening's lesson; and thereby gain such knowledge as I am prepared

to receive. Accept my appreciation of your care and teachings, for I am truly grateful to you for your help, and I desire to be worthy of your love. May the light of the God-spirit illuminate my soul. Amen. Sing a verse of Nearer My God to Thee. Commit the above prayer to memory if possible; but if you have to read it, have barely enough light to do so; then extinguish all light except the two small candles.

Take your position as last week, before the mirror, and relax in body; being in a peaceful frame of mind to receive impressions. Look into the mirror for about five minutes if possible without straining your eyes; but if strain is felt, change the direction of the gaze to a smooth or plain background, such as a plain space of the wall. Never look upon pictures during the sitting, for one is likely to imagine faces forming within the lines of pictures, and we must not deceive nor mislead ourselves by such superficial experiences.

Your inner self should have grown by now until you can see the deeper expression of life's lessons written upon the reflection in the mirror, and as you gaze into your own eyes, it will be easy to learn many things about yourself of which you have not dreamed before. Hatreds will be shown more plainly than love, if you are quite honest with yourself; for the old nature is there only buried by the complexities of social usage, and the veneer of pretense. In these lessons we can afford to be honest with ourselves, for we are alone with God and the teachers to whom all is revealed without our consent. So let us make the most of our opportunities and learn all we can during our lesson hour. If, as I hope there may, forms appear within the mirror, you may witness the presence of the teachers, and perhaps some souls who are anxious for recognition. If all is peaceful, welcome them; if not, as sometimes happens, ask the teachers to take them away and help them to find their place in the Cosmos.

# TO GAIN SPIRITUAL SUCCESS

REFERENCE is given for those spirits of noble incentive and profound wisdom, because they yield not to any backward impulse or unseemly suggestion. And let it be known that the average spirit is very much like the average citizen of the re-

public; he is neither mediocre nor superlatively a genius, but rather gifted with a fair and full modicum of common sense.

So bring them to you with a cordiality that is sincere, without fear, and you will soon "sense" their presence, ready to "do their bit" for struggling humanity.

There is no greater barrier to spiritual success than to have a mind which entertains doubt and fear. So it is not only expedient but wise to cast aside those two backward qualities of failure and then you can start with your fearless investigation of spirit phenomena with assurance of reaching definite conclusion regarding their evidence or proof of spirit-force and spirit-return.

Accompanying the demonstrations of psychical phenomena are certain features which point to their genuineness. And one must first feel assured that they are genuine spirit evidences of spirit-return; then all will be well.

It can hardly be expected that any medium for spirit manifestations will fail to do his or her duty. But it is reasonable to assume that spirits do cheerfully return to accommodate us with a message. First, let us have a strong feeling of brotherly cooperation, and one hundred per cent of other things will be added.

It is a play interesting to Spiritualists, and after the performance a colored medium, Miss held a seance with especial effort to receive the message from the late Harry Houdini. I felt the greatest admiration for Miss ---- to stand before the nonbelievers and, under the ridiculing conditions, did not expect her to obtain results.

"A few Spiritualists were present. Several times I felt compelled to speak and finally did. I asked them to stop the laughter and to be just as reverent as though they were in church. I asked for harmony, to sing hymns, and I felt pleased that Miss -----spoke herself and asked them not to condemn.

"A representative from a Scientific Magazine was present and announced his magazine offered ten thousand dollars to any medium verifying Houdini's message which is in a safe deposit vault.

'It is my sincere wish that a medium will receive the message and show to the world a victorious challenge and convince the skeptics that Spiritualism is a reality."

There is much to be said about Mr. Heald's letter, and we quote below from a letter we sent The Editor of The World (N. Y.) and which seems somewhat an appropriate comment on the above:

"In the Editorial Section of the issue of Sunday, June 10th, appears certain views regarding the so-called controversy, IS DEATH THE END OF ALL? It would be interesting to have the views of Spiritualists to this age-old question. May we as publishers of a magazine of vital interest to truth-seekers and truthfinders put a few questions as a result of observations?

"Why should so many place any dependence on the Jewish History (Bible) or record of prophets of old, if there is nothing after the so-called death? Why, then, mourn for the dead, pray for them, hold memoriams, constantly think about them and talk of them resting in peace? Why so many testimonials of spirit communion, or spirit manifestations, or premonitions, or visions, inspirations and forebodings?

"Our observations have brought us to learn and understand that death is of the body only and the life or spirit carries on and it is not the subject of trickery or laboratory tests. The life has power beyond that of man to give or remove and it can and does prove itself to any open-minded or sincerely willing searcher. Too much is made of its phenomena and too little of its teachings.

"Mankind is and should be vitally interested in what is beyond the portals of this earth realm. From whom, then, can we learn best, they who are here or those who have gone over? It is up to each one to prove it to himself and not take another's meager and prejudiced experience as any criterion. # THE PSYCHOLOGY OF THE SUBCONSCIOUS

E HEAR a great deal today about the subconscious mind and about the result of suggestion to the subconscious mind. The word "sub" means under, subconscious—that which is under or does not reach consciousness. Now the five senses are the consciousness. When these are closed as in the

avenues of consciousness. When these are closed, as in the trance, hypnotice or sleep states, we are unconscious of earth, but conscious of life on another, the spirit plane. The conscious self is in abeyance, and the subconscious self of whose faculties we are normally unaware, is in the ascendant, and the subconscious mind is in operation through the avenues, not of the physical, but of the spiritual senses.

After all, the term, subconscious, is merely one of convenience. Any faculty of the mind which does not pass the threshold of consciousness belongs, of necessity, to the subconscious. Neither are there two selves and two minds, but one self and one mind with many faculties both human and spiritual. The soul is the meeting place for these faculties, the medium for earth and heaven. The psychology of the soul includes a study of these faculties which reach out into two worlds, the subconscious faculties reaching out into spirit and the conscious into earth.

Says Judge Daniel A. Simmons—"There constantly resides within you a mind which is very wise and very powerfully constructive. This mind is something entirely apart from the mind which you consciously use in your every-day affairs. In the language of psychology, this mind that builds, sustains, repairs and operates the body is called the subconscious mind." Now to prove the existence of a subconscious mind it is only necessary to show that there are those phases of mind operation which can not be consciously carried on, and here we have them. None of us can, by any means, consciously "build, repair, sustain and operate the body, which is the temple of the living God," spirit.

Viewed from this standpoint, all life is divine, for all life is of, and from, the Creator. Life is a gift to us, something which we did not command. Life, spirit is divine and perfect in all of its operations. It is we, ourselves, who are imperfect. A man is, after all, no more than his physical inheritance, albeit his spirit is both immortal and divine. Although the player be divine, if the instrument is poor and many times worthless, strains of divine harmony cannot result. Life shows itself in countless forms, but the beauty and perfection of its manifestation is restricted by the form itself. Life, when freed from the hamperings of the physical, becomes so marvelous in its manifestations that we, noting its manifestations, in our ignorance often refer to them as "supernatural happenings."

As we have known consciousness on the physical plane, so shall we know consciousness on the spirit plane, either now, by the powers of mediumship, or later, by the fuller release of death. We are very like something which was once all tightly rolled up, and now we are evolving, unrolling. Within us, yet unrolled, yet unevolved lie all those divine powers of which we are to be the heir. These undeveloped powers, for convenience's sake, and often for a lack of better understanding, are called the subconscious powers. We humans are just beginning to realize these wonderful powers and what they may accomplish for us. These powers all operate according to natural law, which law is God's law. It is for us to know and understand these laws that we may the better cooperate with them. It is even possible that man, as man, might live forever if he understood and could carry out perfectly all the laws which pertain to his being. In youth, spirit is one with our bodies, every cell vibrates joyously. In age, we are just as much of a spirit entity as in youth, but the life force can no longer operate through diseased and dying tissues and so death results. And when spirit leaves matter, matter decays, disintegrates, and is absorbed back into its ele ments.

It has been found that more healthful conditions may be brought about through suggestion to the subconscious or developing self, whose will because of undevelopment is still natural and unconscious. Formerly hypnotism was much used to throw the subject into an unconscious state, in which state he was able to receive the suggestions of the hypnotist. Today an attempt is being made to correct ills by the use of autosuggestion. As the subject approaches the unconscious state of slumber he is to repeat to himself the formula, "Every day in every way I am getting better and better," or whatever he may have decided upon. Phonograph records which play suggestions softly while the patient sleeps are now manufactured. In his waking moments he must cooperate with the suggestions given, refusing to allow himself to think negative thoughts of failure and illness. In this way be endeavors to cooperate with the healing power of spirit.

Some will smile at this and say, "If we lived naturally we would live happily and would not need all these suggestions," which may well be true. Yet so successful has this method be come that during the last decade hundreds of Schools of Psychology have sprung up in America all based upon this principle of rightly guiding the inner self. One school claims 650, 000 testified business and health successes as a result of its efforts. Another is busy teaching 60 different psychologists. The teaching staff of another has a whole galaxy of Ph.D.s, M.D.'s and A.M.'s. Another school claims to have actually cured by mental suggestion at least 25 different diseases.

Now we, who are spiritualists, who believe through demonstration in life to come, through the power of the spirit to sustain itself, should understand and appreciate this light which is dawning for the human race, for in it we see the everliving and healing power of the spirit being demonstrated.

But there are moral laws as well as physical laws, what of them? If I do not obey the moral laws of God I am slain spiritually.

There was a time when we lived as animals do, following our natural instincts; nor were we immoral, because, as we say now, we knew no better. But as we built by effort, and reason dawned, we saw that it was wrong to strike our brother down, or, let us say, to tear and hurt for wanton cruelty. Thus conscience was born and the struggle with what has been called sin began. Laws were formed to restrict and control certain acts. Today, because we are evolving from the merely animal to a higher plane, we are passing through a state of development where there is a conflict between the higher nature of spirit and the lower or purely animal state. There are spiritual laws and we must obey them, and until we do, we shall suffer in the conflict, for the laws of God are both physical and spiritual.

Doubtless we shall some day reach that high plane of perfection into which some are now entering where we will see

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the necessity of controlling, not only every act, but every thought, and a new struggle will begin. Angels looking down on men must say of us, "Man is still unmoral, still in his in-fancy, for in his thoughts he commits all those crimes which he now forbids his body to accomplish."

No more did they disobey the warnings that reached them through their niece as the medium, while each time they offered a thanksgiving for her protecting care.

EDITORIAL NOTE: This is representative of many ac. tual experiences that some of our readers have known to hap pen right in their own households. Let us be frank about such cases and acknowledge as well as understand them.

# **RELIGION PARAPHRASED**

T IS impossible to describe the first form of religious worship of deity, but we do know that man has ever turned his attention to something beyond his personal knowledge of creation. And long before organized society placed the seal of approval over the signature of religion, men worshipped God. In the beginning there could scarcely have been clergymen to officiate at the services held, and a chaotic form would be the result. As time and circumstances developed in the minds of the people the need of official clergy, they chose the most capable men to serve them as leaders and gave them the position of mediator between themselves and God, for they believed in a God of anger, who punished severely all those who disobeyed His mandates. And it was to appease the anger of this God (or in many instances several Gods were recognized, one for each element in nature); and thus the living sacrifice came into existence. And along with the sacrificial service a crude and ugly attitude sprung up toward the races that were considered enemies: war was supposed to be under the direction of the Gods, and victory was looked upon as a sure sign of the God's approval; defeat was caused by the God's disapproval.

Now, with the people looking to the priests to interpret God's wishes for them, is it any wonder that abuses grew out of such a situation and that the priests came to impose their desires in the place of what should have been God's will? They were the most intelligent to begin with, and, naturally they were able to deceive their ignorant followers by telling them that God said thus and so, when perhaps the priest alone would benefit by the decision. Out of this state of affairs grew the power of priesthood, and that power was emphasized when priests were given the power that under democratic or republican rule is reserved for our politicians. They governed with an iron hand and were most despotic in their treatment of the common people, but were less severe upon those of wealth, who might, under excess pressure, turn upon the priests and remove them from office or lessen their power, which as we know did take place later. The rule of the priests in the beginning and the church as a body later on has always been tyrannical and prejudiced. The more republican countries have learned to fear the consequences of religious influences in politics, when such rule gave to any one denomination supremacy in matters pertaining to state affairs. Strange to say, big-otry has always resulted from such relationship, and oppression because of church influence in politics, although one would suppose that religion would soften the hardness of all who really believe in God. History contradicts the supposition.

On the other hand, today we have a too free translation of religion that leads to near-atheism, if it does not actually declare against churches and all forms of worship by the people of any diety, other than NATURE. They have gone from excess superstition to the other extreme, and refuse to acknowledge a God-head, or to follow the teachings of any church or cult, claiming the elements as GOD. These extremes seem natural to humanity, so unstable and contrary at its core. They are the result of abuses by the governing classes, who have always considered their own interest first and have been governed by their inherited desire for power rather than a sense of justice.

No sooner than a man or woman find themselves possessed of power, than they are tempted to exercise that power

to their own advantage. They forget that the people have shown their confidence in the integrity of the person they have chosen, and by act, seem to believe that the power vested in them is for their own personal benefit. It is this human weakness that proves conclusively the need for a balance to intelligence, beside confidence in integrity. We must have an ideal. We must turn to a power so superlative in character that we implicitly trust its sense of justice. We must know in what measure we are entitled to consideration by this superlative power. We must align ourselves on the side of the noblest interpretation of GOOD, not with the freer translation. We must affiliate with persons of high ideals, whose intention is to lead clean lives, at what-so-ever cost, and who cannot be bought with the social toys of destruction. The people who pose as leaders must exemplify their interpretation of God's law in their daily lives. They must set aside all personal considerations beside the necessities of comfort and health in order to make their message more impressive. They must let their light so shine that others seeing their good works will be satisfied with the result, and also willing to follow suit. "No good comes of evil," is a common expression, yet through suffering are we born into the world, and by suffering-which is called evil-are we made worthy of God's Love, providing we accept the scourge of suffering for disobedience and improve our behavior.

In Spiritualism we have the most perfect example of God's provision for our needs. He has permitted the ex-carnate soul to visit the inhabitants of earth to teach us some of the lessons that are learned in this way only, for one cannot know a country until they visit it, or learn of it from those who have. That is the situation: spirit people visit earth people to describe life to them and to help them understand the purpose of suffering, that the knowledge will train them in patience, and the promise of freedom from present obstacles in future planes will engender confidence in God's Love for them.

Spiritualism as a cult is not responsible for the TRUTH, it is merely the vehicle for broadcasting TRUTH and means by which others may come to know the reason for many things that could not be explained without this particular vehicle. Too many of the Spiritualist clergy have not awakened to their responsibility, but as the public makes greater demands upon them they will be forced to recognize their responsibility, and, because they are in touch with higher influences, they will learn to govern their activities according to the instructions given by the more advanced teachers of spirit spheres. Until we have learned our lessons and effaced self from the picture, we must go on doing the best we know how, trusting to God and our fellow-man to excuse our shortcomings, and eventually we shall reap the reward of patience and long-suffering, reserved for those who do His Will, as they are able to interpret it.

And Jesus answering said unto them, do ye not therefore err, because ye know not the scriptures, neither the power of God?

For when they shall rise from the dead, they neither marry, nor are given in marriage; but are as the angels in heaven.

And as touching the dead, that they rise: have ye not read in the book of Moses, how in the bush God spake unto him saying, I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac and the God of Iacob?

He is not the God of the dead, but the God of the living: ye therefore do greatly err.

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
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The organization that comes forth with this periodical does so not for name nor for material gain. The great struggle to overcome doubt and fear requires the generous support of all who will join hands with us.
