Science Proving Man's Soul Exists Apart from his Body



HE YEARS are approaching fast when man will be compelled to overhaul his ideas about his soul and what happens to it after bodily death.

The day that the first atom bomb was dropped on Hiroshima, the reli-

gious notions of two thousand years did a somersault, although only a little handful of thinkers grasped it. The reason was this—

The explosion of the first atom bomb proved beyond further doubt that Science had correctly fathomed the nature of the atom. If it hadn't done so, the processes by which the bomb was exploded wouldn't have worked. The fact that they did work, showed that the atom was constructed as the fission experts assumed.



Every atom was a miniature planetary system. The proton or core held a position equal to the sun in our solar system. The electrons were the several planets rotating about it in orbits. Interfere with those planetary electrons so that they abandoned their prescribed course around their proton-sun—in other words, send

> them off about other business—and you had a shattering of atomic structure that meant more than disaster for the atom itself.

BUT to get to the spiritual aspects of the thing-

The protonic core of the atom was symbolic of the sun in the solar system. The electrons were the planets. But from the first, all scientists had agreed that reckoned by relative mass, just as much free space existed between each proton and electron in the atom as existed between the sun and its planets in universal Space. That is the stupendous thing we must never forget.

The protonic sun in each atom, and the electronic satellites, were so unimaginably *small* that the space between them couldn't be envisioned. And right there, when the scientists proved this by their detonation of the bomb over Hiroshima, religious notions about man's soul went kapoot. Why?

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Because science had demonstrated that man's soul had little or nothing to do with Matter excepting inhabit it. And that meant what, practically?

It meant that the Biblical account of God forming man of the dust of the ground and "breathing into his nostrils the breath of life" was nothing but a pretty symbology. God couldn't have formed man of the dust of the ground, because the dust of the ground was nothing more nor less than the proton-electron atoms that went to make the dust. And those were 999/1000ths pure space and naught else! . .

DR. A. S. EDDINGTON, Plumian Professor of Astronomy in the University of Cambridge, England, told us in the Gifford Lectures as early as 1927, "The atom is as porous as the solar system. If we eliminated all the unfilled space in a man's body and collected his protons and electrons into one mass, the man would be reduced to a speck just visible with a magnifying glass."

Later he went on to say-

"The accepted conclusion at the present day is, that all varieties of matter are ultimately composed of two elementary constituents-protons and electrons. Electrically, these are the exact opposites of one another, the proton being a charge of positive electricity and the electron a charge of negative. But in other respects their properties are very different. The proton has 1840 times the mass of the electrons, so that nearly all the mass of matter is due to its constituent protons. The proton is not found unadulterated except in hydrogen, which seems to be the most primitive form of matter, its atom consisting of one proton and one electron. In other atoms, a number of protons and a lesser number of electrons are cemented together to form a nucleus and can even escape from the atom and wander freely throughout the material. The diameter of an electron is about one fifty thousandth of the diameter of the whole atom; that of the nucleus is not very much larger. An isolated proton is supposed to be much smaller still."

So much for Eddington, the first of our nuclear scientists. But what does it mean, boiled down into facts for the Man in the Street?

T MEANS that he's got to face up to the fact that his self-conscious soul, even though it operate from forty to seventy years in his body, must be a thing apart from it. If, as the materialist contends, the aliveness of the body accounts for the soul, what have we to say for the scientific proof that "the atom is as porous as the solar system"?

The soul of man must be a permanent essence unto itself from the simple fact that there would appear to be as much free space within the human body's atoms as there appears to be between the earth and Old Sol. So we're faced by the challenge, if the self-conscious soul of man can inhabit the physical assembly made up of utterly porous atoms, why can it not exist of itself in free space outside such assembly?

Can we say that the self-conscious soul of man inhabits any one atom in that grand assembly? If so, which one? Is it inside one atom in the head, the stomach or the feet?

The process in Psychology is known as Going Back on the Time-Track . .


Cosmic Facts of Life that Should Be Known to Every Adult Who **Assumes** He Created His Own Children . .

WHAT the average man doesn't understand is, that the marvelous storehouse of the Subconscious Mind holds the detail of everything the human soul has ever witnessed, heard, or participated in. And as it gets a more and more active stirring up-or is trained to probe back and recall finer and finer detail-everything it has ever witnessed or felt is recalled easier and easier. Only here is the stupendous and revolutionary thing that comes to light-

If he or she didn't, the so-called heavenly afterlife would have small significance because identity could never be established. If people couldn't remember who they had been in mortality, how could the slightest responsibility for their deeds in flesh be chalked up against them for future rewards or punishments? And vet, if memory is strictly a physical-brain exercise, how can such cells operate and relinquish their loads of identifying recollection, seeing the physical brain has been buried in a grave along with the rest of the mortal remains? It has to be one thing or the other. They can't have it both ways. They can't say in one breath that fleshly brain is the vast repository of earthly memories, and yet earthly memories continue along into the heavenly state but the body with literal brain be interred and permitted to decompose.

But here is the still more disturbing fact—

WHEN individuals are so treated for full restoration of detailed memory, and thus reach back through the gates of fleshly birth and before, they not only recall detail of the Planes of Thought immediately preceding that fleshly birth, but it comes back with more or less vividity to them whom they have been, and what they formerly did, as individuals in previous worldly life.

Going back on the Time-Track, in other words, or permitting the Subconscious to be opened by nocturnal hypnotism, perturbingly confirms the muchdebated Eastern doctrine of Reincarnation.

If man wishes to live again, on graduating from his physical body, he must be consistent and admit that without a doubt his soul-spirit has lived and experienced before. By no means was his literal soul "created" by the connubial functions of his most recent parents. All they created was the fleshly instrument which his previously conscious soul undertook to occupy to make him an apparent "living" human being in the present historical sequence of earthly time.

All of us have lived before!

The circumstance that each one of us has lived many, many times before, would account it seems for the puzzle of individualistic character, which the unlettered and unlearned psychologist delights to explain by traits of Heredity. The psychologist knowing nothing of these deeper physiological matters attributes such character-formation to factors that in some mystical fashion have become "passed along" through the "blood" of father and mother.

Now in the field of modern psychical science and mental therapy we are coming squarely up against the proposition that personal traits may by no means have been physically inherited but are the resultings from personal experiencings in earlier bodies and sequences.

Thus the question arises, What process is involved, or what conditions require to be complied with, for a soul on the higher octaves of life to decide to return into earth-life again and undergo further physical experiences to the soul's educational profit? . .

SOULCRAFT has published an entire book on this momentous inquiry. Its title is Getting Born.

We don't probe far into the true composition of subconscious mind before we come face to face with the Power of Thinking on octaves above the mortal. The average church member has been told, and has sincerely accepted what the patriarchs of old expounded to himtheir knowledge born of the same times that held the earth to be the center of the solar system and the sun, moon and stars to revolve around it-that when he quitted his physical body at "death" he mounted up to allegorical Pearly Gates and was admitted or not admitted by St. Peter to realms of bliss and eternal attendance upon God. It was his "soul" that did this, leaving his brain-cells behind in his cadaver to become decomposed. But what the soul was, and where it got its powers of identity and memory was never made clear by the sacred writers.

Now fundamental beliefs are altering before the data of Sacred Psychical Research. They're being forced to change their complexions because Sacred Psychical Research is turning up and laying down the *facts*.

When you relinquish your physical vehicle at "death" it's your Etheric Double, or Pattern Body, that quits the molecules of your physical self and goes through the series of after-life experiences. It's been in this Etheric Double or Pattern Body that the real intellectual You has resided all your mortal days. Stunning as

the information may be to some, this Etheric Double may be photographed and otherwise proven to have existence apart from your physical self. The selfconscious You as a thinking and observing entity proceeds right along to observe and experience and remember. But it makes a still more perturbing discovery .

The minute it quits this mortal octave, Creative Thought takes charge instead of the reverse. On *this* plane of atomic reality, Matter is Lord God. It pushes and collides with the Etheric Double enhoused in flesh, and generally compels it to fetch and carry. The moment physical death has released it, the Thought Powers of the Etheric Double are wellnigh transcendent. They can order Matter to do whatsoever they direct.

This means, among other things in practice, that the freed spirit can instantly command itself to "be" anywhere it wishes to be, and it finds itself there. It may be the allegorical heaven high above terra firma or it may be in the developing embryo of an earthly woman's body. But it can *locate* itself by taking thought wherever it desires.

There are occasions and conditions where it may prefer to return into physical worldly life and go along with physical living to obtain spiritual lessons it flunked in its most recent existence. It has but to readjust its atomic-frequency rate to the rate of the embryo in the expectant mother, and within the coming nine months it will find itself projected back upon this world-plane to live another sixty to seventy years as a fleshand-blood mortal.

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How, Where, and When Do We Reunite with Our Affinities beyond Earth?



T IS entirely agreeable to the average person to be informed that somewhere in Cosmos, either in this earth-

world or outside of it—he or she has a cosmic double, too carelessly identified as his or her "affinity." Such cosmic double isn't exactly a replica so much as a completion of the self in the opposite sex.

The supposition seems to be that millions of years bygone, at the commencement of the soul's early entries into material form, it passed through a period or sequence of spiritual coma, during which it divided its attributes. All its independent, aggressive, self-evident and assertive traits gradually became dominant in a physical body that was called the Male. All its conservative, modest, dependent, and constructive traits gradually became distinctive in a body known as Female.

The traits of both, considered in total, made up one Completed Soul. But such halving permitted the masculine division to act and react on its Feminine division, function as the parents of offspring, and generally live out a tandem life together, each profiting by contact with the opposing modes of the other.

The supposition in all forms of socalled Mysticism from the Greek Orphic onward has always been that physical man and physical woman, considered as such, have actually been only half-souls.

From the earliest days of Hebraic theology—from which Christian ecclesiasticism largely comes—this cosmic folklore was largely ignored but the division itself preserved in theory as "the Deep Sleep -which fell upon Adam" when the Midianite Jehovah extracted a rib from Adam's side and shaped it into Eve, the "helpmate."

But one thing has been certain, what-



ever the pattern by which the separation was achieved, it has been a foregone conclusion that between two such halves of the same master-soul, no matter how widely separated they become in any given mortal sequence, the closest compatibility and understanding affection has always maintained. A man or woman wedded to his or her correct affinity in any given earth-life was assumed to realize the maximum of connubial happiness and tranguillity.

THE THEORY has always had it that two such halves making the common master-soul operates at practically the same frequency of etheric vibration, thereby coming to "understand" and tolerate one another with unusual sympathy. To such premise is laid relationships otherwise nonexplainable when a man meets a woman or a woman meets a man who feel "they have known each other always" and seem to pick up connubial lives together as by mutual consent and a matter of course. On the other hand, when marriages occur in which any such subconscious understanding is lacking, the ensuing hostilities are usually immediate and baneful. The man's alibi is, "I guess I married some other chap's better half," or the woman feels romance has passed her by because she doesn't receive from her partner what she had been led by her own deeper emotions to expect.

The whole hypothesis is known throughout theosophic and eastern Mysticism as "the Duality of the Soul." Certainly it is a fact that almost no other explanation exists for the almost unbelievable polarities that continually are demonstrated when "a man meets the woman who belongs to him." The woman herself accepts such circumstance without a murmur and settles down to a lifetime of service, content to re-

ceive its wages in spontaneous affection, if little else. The Soulcraft book, Adam Awakes, gives over 300 pages to every phase and angle of this Affinity acceptance. As an earthly prospect, it is the secret dream of every adolescent's heart, either masculine or feminine. And women as a sex cherish it until their heads are silver.

The more academic philosopher—usually masculine—is intrigued by subtle aspects of such polarities, and entirely aside from locating a scapegoat theory on which to pile blame for matrimonial bellicosities, taken as they come, seeks to know the *why* of such division, the extent of its run, and when under what conditions—if ever—the two soul-halves may fuse and thereafter function singly as before the cleavage.

Thereupon we leave the field of soulpolarity as such in the individual instance and get into more massive knowledge of every soul's destiny further on up the Cosmic Octaves . .

One thing should never be done, however, and that is attempt to explain such matters from any orthodox premise. VALOR



IT STANDS to reason that the Planes of Existence as they are offered to our intellectual graspings in seried form are by no means alike, else there would be no sense in classifying them according to distinctions.

The various higher planes are what they are because on each the individual soul-consciousness learns a different lesson or gets a different profit from effects on spirit. If this were not so, or there weren't special results to be gotten on each loftier octave, all life might be confined strictly to this earth-plane and go on here forever. Actually, existence on this material plane of earth concerns such profit as lies in the disciplines of or from materials.

This is the plane where soul-man enters into fleshly vehicle to battle constantly and continually against earthly forces and circumstances largely outside of his control. He first enhouses in a great clumsy body that is glued to the planet's surface by gravity, that can't leap more than two to three feet off the surface of its own muscular power nor transport itself by swiftest running more than six to eight miles an hour. Added to that, such body must be fed, bedded, clothed and protected from collision and disease. All this circumscription must occur on a plane where life is highly competitive, where bellicosities can quickly develop into bone shattering struggle for survival, and where all degrees and temperaments of culture and self-restraint, or lack of them, are turned into the common arena of society to work what good or harm on one another they can or do accomplish. Spirit is more than merely imprisoned in the confinement of the body. Its situation is similar to confinement in a closed motorcar that of itself may run wild down any grade and kill or maim anyone so luckless as to be a passenger. As soulman perfects his agility in steering or driving such vehicle regardless of his handicaps and disadvantages, it is said of him that he lives life "successfully."

He does nothing of the sort. He lives a physical sequence where such disciplines of gravity and materials cause him to appreciate and evaluate the conditions of the next immediate planes higher where his situation is directly reversed. Instead of materials controlling him, he controls materials. However, such control of materials would hold little significance for him unless he had passed a gruelling tuition as the butt of circumstance instead of its arbiter.

Getting through the sheol-plane of purgatorial darkness directly above his earth-life, soul-man attains the sensation of supervising and directing materials and self-supply through Thought on the Third and Fourth Planes. Read Soul Eternal if you're interested in knowing specifically the distinctions of these levels. Then, after graduating from the Fourth Plane and gettting upon the Fifth, with or without his affinity-companion as the case may be, he begins to prepare or condition himself to bid adieu to form as any qualifying factor whatsoever in his ideology at all.

THE FIFTH Plane seems to be the plane of spiritual amalgamation with kindred soul-people of precisely similar attainments. Matter and Form have been so mastered by the time of eligibility to the higher zones of the Fifth that even the separations or distinctions of male and female vehicles are immaterial. Spirit joins with spirit, not only in the affinity sense but in the group social sense, as fire blends with fire. If two tremendous torches be moved together, it merely means that the quantity of combustion and illumination is doubled. Probably this is one of the chief reasons that in the higher terminology the Fifth Plane is known as the Plane of Flame.

It doesn't mean anything especially igneous. It means, Light, Brilliance, powerful radiation—and a general uniting of Group Soul luminaries into a cosmic force ready to take off into Timelessness but controlled by a supermind.

Too many earth people, visualizing reunion with their sex polarities try to picture some ridiculous happening like Jehovah putting Adam back to sleep again and shoving Eve back into him. The trouble with them is, they're trying to conceive in strictly earthly factors. By the time that Soul-man reaches the higher zones of the Fifth Plane, he has wellnigh relinquished body itself, existing fully conscious only in *outline*.

It's a spiritual exactness in character and its achievements that occurs on the highest zone of the Fifth Plane, and the character force is doubled as the two halves of the original Soul reunite in a double-sized exhibit of potential strength to achieve unto functions that are unimaginable on this shallow and circumscribed Plane of Earth.

This is the kindergarten plane for all life. Little human children with inhibited or undeveloped mentality are attending it. But gradually they develop themselves away from it.

"He rates the karma," the answer comes, "of returning into earth-life and reaping personally what he formerly sowed that made others suffer."


We might demand, shocked by the leniency of this, "You mean he's supposed to come back into flesh and be murdered himself thirty million times?"

"Because," they answer, "we learn Out Here in our beyond-mortality status the true nature of Holy Spirit."


We ask, "What's that got to do with it?"

Comment: Might the Long Table answer such challenge by an analogy? Admittedly Christianity as a theology is only 19 centuries old. For five thousand ears prior to the coming of Jesus something like 200 generations of human beings worshiped the sun as the universal deity, more than twice as long as good Baptist Texans have adulated the divinity of Christ. During those 200 generations of sun worship, humanity didn't believe in any hell on the medieval Christian pattern any more than good Soulcrafters believe in it today. If men for 5,000 years had been deifying the sun how did the followers of Jesus dare make the claim that Christianity alone knew all about the Holy Trinity and precisely where people went at death? You would probably say that they learned it through Jesus' appearance and teachings, that He told them, being the Son of God. But why should He wait 5,000 years to do it? What Long Table is saying is, the length of time that society may have entertained erroneous spiritual beliefs has nothing to do with Truth in any case. For three to five thousand years in Egypt men worshiped Osiris and Isis. What became of them and the Greek and Roman pantheon of gods? As men work nearer and nearer to correct interpretations of Cosmic Truth, they innovate fiiner and more ethical religious tenets. As for Soulcraft ever saying there is no Hell, you can't have read its doctrines very extensively. What Soulcraft has said it, there is no hell such as depicted by such medieval poets as Dante and Milton. There is, between the hard-material plane of planetary earth and the Third Heaven or Plane of Largess a purgatorial Sheol octave of consciousness through which souls of no spiritual development must make their ways to come out into ultimate Light and association with the etheric beings populating the Third-as well as others higher up. It seems to be a condition of bleakness, ugliness and darkness because its inhabitants lack the eligibility to go higher. They specify such allocation for themselves by their brutality, ignorance, or coarseness of temperament while in the incarnations of flesh. The moment they begin to develop spiritually, they start working out of it. It has undoubtedly been the reality of such selfimposed damnation that has furnished the poetic or allegorical cues for religious perdition. But medieval ecclesiasticism specified that certain exhibits of mankind got there by the celestial machinery of the Osirian-Egyptian Judgment Hall, and that once consigned to it Soul-man was "lost" forever. stars revolving around it. Man is by instinct a worshiping animal, not only because of the supernatural phenomena he confronts constantly in life which he attributes perforce to Deity but because he retains subconscious memories of the Thought Planes where he resides between fleshly incarnations. Now in the wake of scientific analysis of the atom, psychical research has come to the fore devoid of theologic persecutions. This has enabled rational facts about higher sojourns to be learned by word of mouth from intelligent beings who have survived the death transition. Hence Soulcraft, premised on their attestments. It is professedly Christian because it accepts and adulates the celestial tenets of Christ, as the greatest Avatar-Teacher the earth has ever had. Likewise, figuring from your hybrid orthodoxy as evidenced by your query about one half the soul getting lost in hell, you rest your argument on the assumption that such a thing happens. If you were conversant with the Soulcraft volumes Behold Life, Adam Awakes, and Undying Mind, and particularly the current book Soul Eternal, you would acquire a more comprehensive view of what the Soul itself is, and why the cleavage into sex-traits came about. Yes, and even Star Guests should not be overlooked. Your concept of the Soul is that of the personality of an individual because there has evidently been only One Completed or reunited Soul-man ever appear on this plane. You think of Soul as heterogeneous spirit-personality because you've never seen anything else, nor can you on a plane where spirit can only operate through flesh. 


