

All that ever had or ever will have existence exists eternally in the Now; and were the inspiration of the Infinite to forever feed the flame within and fully illumine the fathomless depths of the soul, then perchance there should be revealed unto us innumerable hosts of Truth—truths hidden away and forgotten in the secret vaults of the soul since they were garnered there from reality countless eons ago. Nor should it excite our wonder if in that incomprehensible past the immortal soul had gathered unto herself the elements of all power.

Have you not felt the glowing warmth of the Invisible Presence? Have you not been moved by the guivering of the All Power within? Have you not believed in moments of deep seriousness that there was recognizable within your being the presence of a mysterious and inexplicable energy, which, could you only command it, would gain for you the highest expression of love, health, happiness and prosperity-the greatest well being? Then let me assure you, awakened soul, the conviction inherent within your consciousness is not delusive. There is a power within, which, when once you become fully conscious of it, will enable you to gain all these things, and this is the message I am sending to you full and clear. The knowledge of Occult Power is at hand-the Deliverer is here.

No matter what your past beliefs have been, no matter how long you have vainly sought for the hidden power to transform the erring self, no matter how many times you have attempted to gain a higher expression of the living ideal, the true, the beautiful—and have failed; if you will carefully read what is here written and assimilate the truths contained herein, the inherent divinity of your nature will henceforth impel you to manifest a higher, brighter, happier and healthier life than ever before.

I am making no false promise nor idle claim. I literally mean every word I say. I am inspired to reveal unto you the secret of all power. The information to be imparted to you in this essay has enabled me to gain an insight into the law of life, accompanied in many cases by power approaching the miraculous. It will do the same for you. With its aid thousands have been helped to self-control, happiness and prosperity. It will help you. It will bring you into oneness with Infinite power. It is the grand arcanum, the philosopher's stone, the secret of secrets, hitherto shrouded in unpenetrable and inscrutable mystery. It is that universal principle permeating all things and superior to every other element. By its aid you may ascend the golden stairway leading up to the heights of spiritual wisdom, whence the soul, gaining a momentary glimpse of Omniscience, emulates Omnipotence and becomes transformed into the Likeness of the Eternal. O Infinite Spirit of Truth, guide us on our way!

Before you can assimilate the knowledge which I am about to present, before you can be illumined by the light of eternal truth, that barrier in the doorway of your soul, that monument of ignorance and superstition whose shadow has long darkened the inner consciousness and shrouded the soul in deepest gloom, that monstrous concept, evil, must be broken down and its elements dispersed. Happy are they who are already free from its shadow.

I say unto you that all your aspirations to Power are utterly vain as long as you believe in the reality of evil, as long as you admit the existence of an erratic element or substance ungovernable by supreme laws, which will not obey when Infinite Wisdom speaks. I say unto you that until the concept, evil, is eradicated from your mind, that you must remain hopelessly impotent----must forever remain in that outer spiritual darkness which knows not faith.

When that great naturalist and philosopher, Humboldt, in the eighteenth century, made his world-famous declaration, "The Universe is Governed by Law," the mystery of orderly existence was forever dispelled. It required over another century, however, before enlightened minds, working in the realm of pure intellect, definitely determined that man is an intelligent atom of Omniscient Mind and subject to the First Law of Mind—The Law of Choice.

This was the crowning achievement of the world's greatest thinkers at the dawn of the Twentieth Century, wherein Science, whose task is, according to Jevons, "the discovery of identity amidst diversity," or in the words of Tynndal, "the verification of the ideal in Nature," by this epoch making generalization, definitely identifying man as a fragment of nature and showing him to be equally subject to natural law, acknowledged the omnipresence of Omniscient Divinity, accomplished the complete destruction of the dogma of human liberty and won the most stupendous intellectual emancipation the world has ever known.

The establishment of this supreme Fact of Being—the Evolution of the Ideal, expressing the conscious knowledge of man through the Law of Choice, is in other words the recognition of Eternal Omniscience in the working of that economy of nature we know as Cosmic Sanity, bringing order from chaos and compelling the conscious individual to express (at least potentially through choice) that which appears to him to be for the greatest value or lesser injury, for himself or his aim.

Through a clear understanding of this psychic fact it becomes at once evident that Will itself is no more or less than the Law of Choice. It follows, therefore, that the determinations of the will are no more or less than the operations of the Law of Choice upon the psychic or mind content of the individual.

The individual, therefore, has no direct power over the determinations of the Will (the operations of the Law of Choice); his province extends only to the me-

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chanical carrying out of the mental picture selected in accordance with the Law of Choice for projection into objectivity. Thus, no individual will exists, there is only the One Will of the One Being—the Law of Choice, which of itself is absolutely perfect and infinitely wise.

While the untrained mind is but beginning to grasp the full significance of the Law of Choice, as presenting the key to the solution of world problems, the principle itself, unnamed and undefined, was long ago recognized and laid down as a metaphysical axiom by the ancient philosophers. Its clear psychological truth is immediately verifiable in all determined action; its opposite expression would be, without the norm, insanity.

Thus it is now known that there is no freedom of the will in the sense that one can do this, that, or the other thing; or that one, under the same circumstances, could have done differently in the past. That would imply an absurd freedom of action which Cosmic Sanity forbids. Cosmic Sanity, manifest in the Law of Choice, compels the individual to do a particular thing, that which he conceives to be for his greatest interest, the greatest value or lesser injury for himself or his plans.

Thus, while the Law of Choice is absolutely perfect and infinitely wise, the nature and wisdom of the choice, just what the individual conceives to be for the greatest value, or lesser ill, for himself or his plans and his consequent conduct, depends entirely upon, is determined by, and varies with, his character, viewpoint, and the degree of intellectual development of his psychic content; and these determining factors are the product of heredity and the mental and physical environs since birth.

Thus, in the words of Von Hartman, "Every human being accordingly brings the main part of his character

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with him into the world; how large in proportion to this is the part which he acquires in addition, depends on the uncommonness and abnormal nature of the circumstances in which he moves. In most cases the habits of one man's life do not suffice to produce far-reaching changes in the inherited character."

Seeing, then, that Character is Destiny, that individual expression is only a pouring forth of that which is within his psychic content, any attempt to change the expression of the individual must be futile unless it primarily operates to alter the organization of his psychic content, that is, his intellect. The complete destruction of the doctrine of the freedom of the will has prepared the way for the only true freedom,—freedom from ignorance. "He is a freeman whom Truth makes free; and all are slaves beside."

When it is possible to estimate aright the character, and intellect of, to calculate, with precision, the exact weight and effect of the multiplicity of influences at work upon, any sane individual at a given moment, the choice and voluntary act of that individual at that moment may be predicted with unerring certainty. And while it is demonstrable that a sagacious and analytical observer, through the recognition of the Law of Choice, may penetrate into the past and correctly predict the future of any individual directly as his character and environment are known, yet, without that manifestation of Cosmic Sanity, the Law of Choice, it is inconceivable that Omniscience should be able to determine future choices and voluntary acts of any individual.

As that, which to the individual at one moment, may appear to be for his greatest value, at another moment, as a result of a new combination of mental elements, may

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appear to be for his greatest injury, we see that the operation of the Law of Choice is purely an intellectual process, entirely independent of the mechanical effect of emotional statistics. In fact, when his intellect is dominated by the appetites or passions, or the suggestions of others, no expression of his intellectual choice is possible or permitted, and the actions of the individual are determined by influences exterior to his intellect.

It is difficult, however, to convince others of a truth for which they have no natural intuition; for ideas and habits of thought, when strengthened by hereditary influences and popular religious teachings, gain a tenacity which only the repeated attacks of the logician and the analyst may overcome.

When we view the wonderful mental and physical achievements of man during the last few decades, it seems incredible that a little over four centuries ago the principal philosophers, the so-called wise men of that time, believed the earth was flat instead of spherical, that our planet was the center of the universe. Yet, inconsistent as it may seem to us, they had no doubts about it; the idea that the earth was round, that beneath their feet there existed another country, where the inhabitants "stood on their heads," where "ships could sail up hill," was, to them, utterly absurd and untenable.

Notwithastanding the mighty mental advances of the present day, the majority of thinkers, like the philosophers of old, are still victims of intellectual short-sightedness; they still cling to old beliefs and dogmas, to the use of terms that should have long ago become obsolete and passed into the oblivion of their inventors; they still cling to the use of words coined in a superstitious age to denote monstrous attributes of fabulous and hypothetical beings.

The belief in the reality, or other than hypothetical existence, of "evil," or its corrollary, "sin," is the most persistent of false concepts that continues to survive in otherwise seemingly sane minds.

From the infinite viewpoint, Nature no longer appears as an aggregation of gross and blind elements in endless strife with Spirit, for every manifestation or form of being we know as matter is itself divine, and the various phenomena of living forms in whatsoever stage of evolution they may be found are but the natural product of forces originally inherent in, or possessed by, conscious and intelligent elements of the universal substance. Infinite substance being, in its ultimate analysis, ONE, we may not consistently say that any individual atom is one jot more or less divine than its fellow; each and all are crystalizations or individual manifestations of the One Substance. What would be more absurd than to assert that the essence of an atom of gold is superior to that of an atom of hydrogen, or that the essence of oxygen is more divine than that of carbon?

For purposes of argument we may assume certain statements of principles, or propositions, to be correct, which, from their very nature, cannot be conceived to be correct now nor ever. For instance, we might state that the mathematicians of Mars are able to divide ten by three without a remainder, or that upon some distant star two plus two equals five? Now, notwithstanding that the meanings conveyed by these statements are clearly intelligible, we at once recognize that the statements them-

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selves are self-contradictory and absurd, mathematical impossibilities.

It is the same with the statement or assumption that "evil" or its corollary, "sin," can have other than hypothetical existence in reality.

For notwithstanding that we have with a rigorous and uncompromising logic revealed the fallacy of the freedom of the will and absolutely established the fact that each volition of the conscious and intelligent mind is inexorably determined by immutable law, the Law of Choice, it seems well nigh impossible for the untrained mind to accept this axiomatic principle of psychology, inasmuch as to do so necessitates the rejection of the popular belief in the reality of "original sin" and "evil," and a revised conception of the nature of man's responsibility and accountability. And with tenacity do the entrenched Powers of Darkness oppose this revised conception, for should it become universal, priests and preachers would be replaced by scientific teachers and temples and churches would make way for institutions of learning where primitive minds would be taught literal and exact truth. developing a prescient faculty in all, showing the adverse outcome of limited intelligence.

The assumption of "evil" is based upon the belief that there exists, or can exist, in our universe an erratic or inharmonious element or entity, with such nature that it is directly opposed to all order and progress, and which has inherent sufficient dynamism to enable it to resist the operation of cosmological law; being so disposed, also, that were it to acquire all knowledge, it would still seek to accomplish certain aims and purposes, regardless of the welfare of itself or others, or of the inharmony it created in the universe. This, evidently, is the only legitimate attributable meaning to the term, "evil"; and, thus defined, it is shown to the rational mind that the existence of "evil," other than as a hypothesis without foundation in reality, is logically absurd.

If, on the contrary, we define "evil" as an attribute of an individual, and then declare that the individual, upon the acquisition of knowledge, may, and does, discard this particular attribute, we affirm by implication the identity of "evil" with ignorance, which renders the hypothesis of the existence of "evil" unnecessary and void.

In order to further convince the logical mind that "evil" has but a hypothetical existence, it is only necessary to present a rule whereby it may be shown that those expressions of being, popularly known as "evil," or "sin," are no more or less than manifestations of ignorance, in which case, therefore, they are remediable by knowledge alone.

In affirming the existence of an entity of such a nature that were it to acquire all knowledge it would still express that condemned by intelligence, that is to say, ignorance, "evil" or "sin," our statement is self-contradictory, as an examination of first principles reveals the fact that "An entity and its attributes or manifestations are identical in essense, that objectivity is merely an expression or projection of subjectivity." All knowledge could not, therefore, express itself out of harmony with, or offensive to, itself. Like must beget like. "As is the outer, so is the inner," is axiomatic; expression is only the pouring forth of that which is within; an entity is that which it expresses, as there can be no dividing line between subjectivity and objectivity. Whether we know it or not, it is this Law of Correspondence which permits us to gain an insight into the nature of things; it is the mystic countersign which opens the door of the Unknown and reveals the mystery of the invisible presence—"the thing in itself." It is this fundamental law, established by the ancient philosophers, which renders untenable the position of those Agnostics who assert that "All being, including God and the human soul, is unknown or unknowable."

CHAPTER VI THE CHART OF MIND

Showing the Historical and Prophetic Cycles of Consciousness and the Correct Sequence of the Distinct Degrees of Intelligence

Psychology, verifying the Hermetic affirmation, "There is but One Law and He that worketh is One," took its place among the inductive, or positive and exact sciences with the advent of the **absolute monism** resulting from the true conception of the oneness of existence achieved in the epoch-making union of science and philosophy, wherein the **inseparableness of spirit**, **mind**, or **energy and matter**, was established in the merging of the chemical law of the "persistence," or "indestructibility of matter," discovered by Lavoisier in 1789, and the physical law of the "persistence of force," or "conservation of energy," demonstrated by Mayer in 1842, into the one great law of the persistence of matter and force," or "the law of substance."

This psychological triumph was the despair of the dualists, who, clinging to their superstitional dogma of actio in distans, the cleavage of cause and effect, or the separation of spirit and matter, had long halted on the shore of Essential Intelligence with the vain hope that some miracle worker might cause the monistic sea to divide itself into a material and a spiritual monism and permit 30 them to pass with their antedeluvian philosophy to the promised land!

Now emerging from dualism, psychology, however, finds itself in temporary difficulties of positive expression because of its relative or dualistic terminology; for the powers and priviliges, qualities and characteristics of mind have been defined without proper consideration of their comcomitance or identity with, and named without the use of ordinal terms showing the correct sequence of, the specific degrees of intelligence.

An unique aid in classifying the attributes of mind in positive ordinal terms is found in the evident natural steps in the at least potential advance of intelligence arising from the enlarging spheres of consciousness resulting from the definite and distinct increases in the elevation of viewpoint.

These natural and distinct viewpoints or steps in potential intelligence are shown on the chart of mind presented herewith and are known as spheres or states of consciousness: 1, Simple; 2, Animal; 3, Self; 4, Family; 5, National; 6, Race; 7, Dual; 8, Spirit; 9, Occult; and 45, Absolute Consciousness; whereupon in a literal or figurative re-birth the cycle is reproduced with characteristics and attributes of intelligence and power greatly magnified.

The nature and origin of that mystery or mysteries consciousness itself—is a problem whose solution forever baffles those rejecting the essential fact of monism—the omnipresence of divinity in the oneness of existence, affirming consciousness to be an essential attribute of all substance and individuals of being, differing only in degree or according to their sphere; the type or value of the individual synthetizing consciousness depending on the stability and adaptation of the organism through which it receives its impressions and expresses its volitions.

Subsidiary to the natural and distinct spheres of essential consciousness there are spheres of collective consciousness resulting from the grouping of individuals into commercial, professional, religious, political and other organizations; also the consciousness we know of as that of a town, city, county, district, state, part of a country, or the grand divisions of the world, or even, according to astrology, that dominating a heavenly body.

All forms of non-human life also have their own distinct consciousness, and considering consciousness in its universal extension to be a potential or inherent attribute of all substance, there would be an etheric and an electronic consciousness, and as many other varieties as there were kinds of individualized elements, each atom of hydrogen having its hydrogenic consciousness, and each atom of carbon its carbonic consciousness, and so forth.

The correct conception of the consciousness of the mind ion of the microcosmic awakened man, or Man-God, is that of an individual differentiation of Infinite Being reproducing or reflecting in itself the forms of the visible universe by building up with monads within its subjective conscious sphere images of the objective forms, monad for atom, the microcosmic atom gaining an electric charge of divine fire, or becoming ionized upon the excess of its psychic monads over the physical atoms, permitting ideal images to be formed.

Here is forever dispelled the clouds, the impenetrable and inscrutable mystery which through countless ages obscured the abode of the ideal. Down in the depths of the microcosmic mind ion is found a center of absolute perfection, the "house not made with hands," which shall be lifted up eternally in the heavens.

The consciousness of the visible universe with the plan of a relative greater objective sphere surrounding it may be conceived struggling through eons to reflect the laws and systems of the greater sphere, even so the mind ion is ever endeavoring to discern the activity and order of the universal sphere surrounding it, that it may build up the ideal within its subjectivity.

Until the mighty laws were discerned and reflected in the evolving elements within the universal consciousness, imperfect groupings crashed into each other and dissolved. forms were built up again and again to be dashed down in confusion. And here is found a parallel in the mind ion struggling to free itself from error. Upon the coming of the vision of the true aim of being the mind ion is dazed and stirred unto its very depths; it knows the contents of its consciousness have neared absolute dissolution, that unless every inner image, abstract group, system and constellation of subjectivity are reformed even to the last monad in order to anticipate and reflect the coming of the once far-off divine event, its most beloved ideals may any moment, in the descent of the new light, crash into the imperfect systems of their fellows, carrying all down into the oblivion of chaos.

Fortunate indeed is the mind ion that hastens to perfect its subjectivity before some great calamity comes to destroy the imperfect ideals, nor waits for that leveler of errors—the "first death"—to reveal the inconsistencies within, but with incessant effort frees its inner consciousness from the erroneous systems thrust upon it by the clouded world sphere, and gains a true conception of the divine purpose, hastening to convey to the inner life those great orders of the higher spheres to which sooner or later all below must show good and sufficient cause why they do not yield. And it were well the awakened mind ion should seek to warn its fellows of the wrath that is to come—the wrath of the Great Judgment Day of the Gods within—when the outraged inner consciousness —conscience with its "thousand several tongues"—the "mad unchained elements" from which the essential Truth has been withheld—shall rebel against the volitions of the Lord sphere of the mind ion, even as in days of old "the stars in their courses fought against Sisera."

It is evident Emerson anticipated the present "war of the spheres" when he gave the warning in the following lines:

"Beware when the great God lets loose a thinker on this planet. Then all things are at risk. It is as when a conflagration has broken out in a great city, and no one knows what is safe or where it will end. There is not a piece of science, but its flank may be turned tomorrow; there is not any literary reputation, not the so-called eternal names of fame, that may not be reviled and condemned. The very hopes of man, the thoughts of his heart, the religion of nations, the manners and morals of mankind, are always at the mercy of a new generalization. Generalization is always a new influx of divinity into the mind, hence the thrill that attends it."

While the character of the natural and distinct degrees of consciousness up to and including Race or Cosmos Consciousness are known and defined in detail, concerning the higher, and to many unknown, degrees or spheres of consciousness attainable in exalted moments both objectively and subjectively to the mind ion of awakened man, little has been recorded in accessible literature. Spirit, or God Consciousness, is referred to in the biblical phrase, "in the **spirit**," while Occult, Lord, or Infinite in Finite Consciousness, is the attribute of the true teacher or prophet of God, whose mind capsule is broken or opened to the divine influx of Absolute Consciousness and in the poetic words of the Belgian seer and mystic, Maurice Maeterlinck, "Be the crevice never so small, yet does it suffice for all the waters of heaven to pour into the soul."

Many mistake Race or Cosmos Consciousness for Absolute Consciousness in that the former reaches its maximum through three successive stages in Self Consciousness expanding to and beyond Family and National Consciousness.

Few are able to survive the passage into the following Dual Consciousness, mystically termed the "first death" (seemingly a conflict with an anti-human consciousness, obsession or insanity), unless an unseen Master aid, guide and rescue the "broken one" from the antagonizing Spirit, or God Consciousness, and overcome "the last enemy," death (the Past—the Lived—Devil, reading backward) by completing the cycle on through the Spirit and the Occult Consciousness into Absolute Consciousness, which latter is really a re-entrance into the magnified Simple Consciousness of the former cycle—the "re-born" entering into seeming death or trance, or in case of previous Mastership, into **conscious unconsciousness** is restored.

Occult, Lord, or Infinite in Finite Consciousness, the testimony of which is "the spirit of prophecy," is, to those who have not experienced the exaltation of this higher sphere, the most difficult to comprehend, being an entrance into a subjective realm of pure and nascent mind with the stunning effect of a broken Wor(l)d and a vision of the ideal restored.

By referring to the chart of mind presented opposite frontispiece, its mind attribute is shown to be Prescience; aim, Mastership and Perfection; effect, Involution and Re-birth; poesy, Sight and Ideal; planets, Asteroids and the Sun; signs, Virgo and Aquarius; approximate time, A. D. 33, 1041, and 1905; order, Infinite in Finite; mystic, Light; chemical elements, Nickel and Cobalt; number, 9 and 405.

The effect of the mind in any sphere of consciousness. while first taking place in the sphere below, ultimately reacts in its own, and is thus shown opposite in the chart. Ignorance in a higher sphere is thus the cause of the Slavery, or "Seeming Evil," in the sphere below, and later its own Slavery, or "Evil," through a more potent mind rebelling among the elements of the lower sphere and ascending and overwhelming the mind ion in the sphere And this rivalry is inevitable from sphere to above. sphere until the Master sphere of Prescience is entered, where the beleaguered and "broken one" is restored by the influx of the Infinite in Finite, and the Lord with the aim of Mastership and Perfection for the Whole reigneth forever and ever protected by the transcending mind attribute or ability of foreseeing the new star of the future rising in Omniscience.

The certain fact of the existence of these definite and distinct degrees or spheres of consciousness, and especially of all-inclusive Absolute Consciousness as attainable attributes of the objective mind ion, or awakened ego, reveals the relativity of **dualism** and establishes **monism** in the essential oneness of existence. Thence arises the divine optimism predicating the coming opening, ionizing

or awakening of every objective ego (without the former concomitant of "death" or disincarnation) upon its response to the touch or Voice of the Infinite in Finite and the realizing anew of divinity—of Eternal Oneness with the all-pervading Invisible Presence of Absolute Consciousness.

The axiomatic psychological Truth—the rock (VROC) of monism-upon which the dualistic ship, burdened with the Karma of ignorance and superstition (knowledge minus or in parable), must inevitably founder, is the fact that the sane mind (there is no true insanity) is determined by the operation of the absolutely perfect and infinitely wise Law of Choice, or Absolute Sanity, indicating its greatest apparent "good." Whether the choice ultimately proves to be wise or unwise as measured by mortal vision is impertinent; the ego may only correctly judge or choose of that which it knows, and the concept of "good" varies with the degree of consciousness. Discrimination, the beginning of mind, is only possible when the wise and the unwise may be distinguished; and it is difficult for one existing in Self Consciousness, where the concept of "good' 'is synonymous with self-preservation, to discover or comprehend the sanity of one existing in Family, National or Race Consciousness, let alone the sanity of one able at times to enter into Dual, Spirit, Occult, and Absolute Consciousness, or the renewed spheres beyond.

Monistic philosophy in showing the omnipresence of divinity affirms that the subjective mind, or soul, manifesting the miracle, man, is what down through the ages has been known as God; and that the incarnated mind ion, or awakened objective ego, is the Lord God, reigning in seeming freedom over the subjective organism, but normally having no true freedom in the realm of mind, and ever courts dethronement by rebelling against or repressing the impulses arising from the subjective God Consciousness.

For the objective ego to strive to free itself from the tyranny of God Consciousness in order to enter into Occult, or Absolute Consciousness, is, under normal conditions, to invite mind disaster, for the Lord, gaining freedom for a season to wander through space and time, finds upon returning to the entranced body a former subordinate mind element advanced to rulership and somewhat unwilling to surrender the new authority; and in the following struggle for supremacy is manifested to the exterior world the puzzling psychic phenomena of the ages, and if the "temple" is not torn, shattered, or thrown down by the rebel within before the Lord regains the throne, it is in momentary danger of injury or crucifixion through the reflex action of that same order, but perhaps a different character, of God Consciousness finding expression through fellow organisms.

At times the incarnate man is fighting against the very God Itself, and the other individualizations of God are sometimes "too many for him" when it comes to physical warfare; and unless he is verily the risen Christ and no more subject to crucifixion, or unless he fights and runs away, or perchance is protected by the Invisible Presence, superior intelligence and absolute faith, he may no longer be King of Kings and Lord of Lords over objectivity.

Victory comes to the faithful and true and "fatality shrinks back abashed from the soul that has more than once conquered her," and the victorious Lord may now merge his Occult Consciousness with the Absolute Consciousness of the Infinite and Eternal, and overcoming all sense of separateness, regain his former divine prerogative and authority to do that which the Law of Choice— Absolute Sanity—operating in the Infinite Sphere, indicates—that which is for the greater value or lesser injury. That is to say, Invisible Presence, Ether, or Spirit—the True God—emerging or reflecting from the Lord mind ion or differentiation of Itself in the organized brain of the Master Man, expresses Itself in action whose nature varies with the character, intelligence, experience, environment and viewpoint of the Christed individual, and through increasing intelligence overcoming the influence of environment, the product of the Law of Choice in the Absolute Sphere and the consequent conduct or expression becomes more and more ideal, the "evil" or slavery of ignorance disappearing.

From the Infinite viewpoint it is seen that man may realize his divine nature and oneness with the Whole in the recognition that in Absolute Consciousness there is no true individual best which is not at the same time absolute best. The Law of Choice is absolutely perfect and infinitely wise and while its product varies with the degree or sphere of consciousness of the individual, its general operation in any sphere of consciousness constitutes the Sanity and results in the ultimate welfare of the individuals existing in that sphere of consciousness.

Manhood is the first step toward Godhood—the attainment of God power over the physical body opening the way to Lordship and the realization of divinity and the sense of immortality here and now—to the entrance into the higher sphere of consciousness where the product of the Law of Choice transcends the norm of human reason and sanity to such a degree that it may impel the individual in a sublime moment to lay down his life for his love, his country, his friend.

And here is the sleeping intellect of the dualist puzzled; not having awakened into the consciousness of his own divinity, fear bred of ignorance instills an instinctive opposition for, and even condemnation of, that which he is not capable of understanding.

Awakening into Absolute Consciousness, the mind is stunned by the mighty potentialities of the exalted sphere and temporarily dismayed lest its aim may not be in alignment with the Absolute Aim; then comes the precious reassurance of Absolute Consciousness in the conviction that the awakening into the absolute sphere is the inevitable divine event of that mind ion whose aim is become one with Infinite Mind.

In this divine moment the angels beckon, for the soul, receiving recognition from on high, reaches supreme ecstasy, becoming for a time one with the Infinite, Omniscient, Omnipresent and practically Omnipotent.

In this divine moment man realizes anew his forgotten divinity and the Eternal purpose of existence—the alignment of the individual aim with the Absolute Aim—the restoring of his lost estate—his rightful heritage predicated by true monistic philosophy and revealing itself in that divine thrill surging through every atom of his being and impelling him, hoarse with emotion, to cry aloud, I AM GOD!

The optimistic power of monism consists in its affirmation of the non-existence of an erratic or "evil" element which disobeys or can disobey when Wisdom speaks, that some may fail to hear or understand the Voice of Wisdom indicates that Infinite Wisdom is not speaking, or, as some may say, because "Truth can no more be per-

ceived by the mind unprepared than the sun can rise in the midst of night." From this hackneyed quotation the cynical and hypocritical have concluded that Truth is not Wisdom. The important fact that an ever-increasing number of sane minds are opposed to this conclusion and affirm that the time is come for minds to be at least prepared to know the Truth predicates the nearing of the new order and the return to first principles.

Attaining to Absolute Consciousness and surprising the secret of existence in the Eternal Urge of Practical Omnipotence in the objectifying of Omniscience throughout Omnipresence, a higher sphere of consciousness is entered where in ascending to the Infinite viewpoint and expanding the former consciousness the new sphere contains all objectivity from the insignificant planet Earth to the most distant star, thence in subjective Omniscience one may choose to wield practical Omnipotence over the former objectivity, now become subjectivity.

Concentrating a mighty inner invisible searchlight upon the former sphere of Race or Cosmos Consciousness, there is revealed a multitude of thought forms, whose purpose perhaps has been served, engaged in mortal combat. From the lofty viewpoint and practical unlimited power over subjectivity a strict neutrality may be maintained, or the exalted one may warn through inspired prophets of the Judgment coming and come, shake the world with temblors and tempests, or strike terror in the hearts of the outlaw and degenerate thought forms by causing the ethereal elements of the slain bodies to appear and speak against the disobedience of the command thundered from Mount Sinai, Thou shalt not kill!

And should all this evidence of the watchful eye of the Invisible Presence fail to restore peace on earth without the perpetual resort to force, perchance a Messenger shall be sent to reveal the True Purpose of existence, and should the world reject the final revelation and crucify again the Christ, then by a supreme effort of the inner volition the centrifugal and centripetal forces shall be suspended and the offending gathering of star dust hurled into the sun!

CHAPTER VII THE CHART OF MIND (Concluded)

Discard all symbolism and accept The Chart of Mind in a literal sense; read both in a horizontal and a vertical direction, note well the name, mind or degree of intelligence, number, aim and effect of the different states of consciousness, and with the Faith that makes Desire Destiny your true aim will indicate the number or degree of your present potential intelligence, the higher sphere of consciousness to which you may have legitimate aspiration.

At birth the normal occidental child emerges from Simple or Absolute Consciousness into Animal Consciousness; between one and two years it becomes Self Conscious; with the awakening of the instinct of parenthood at puberty Family Consciousness dawns; with war, political or physical, comes National Consciousness; with the coming of fire and flood, plague and famine, temblors and other world disasters, "the touch of Nature makes the whole world kin," and humanity on the defensive against the forces of the universe, awakens into Race or Cosmos Consciousness.

Here the dualistic thinkers had placed the limits of human consciousness, but in the monistic conception of the oneness of existence, a few aligning their aims with the Absolute Aim, survived the "first death," and in exalted moments entered into God Consciousness, Infinite in Finite Consciousness, and Absolute Consciousness. In the abnormal Oriental life, the mating for marriage in infancy, the enforced authority of another race, and the frequent and extreme hardships of life itself, have resulted in a subjective mind development of its people far transcending that of the more material-minded nations.

To objectify and make practical the intelligence and latent power of this developing subjective consciousness is the true aim of Monistic Psychology.

The Occult or Infinite in Finite Consciousness is the sphere containing the secret of true and lasting power, and it is to this degree that those having the aim of spiritual unfoldment and psychic re-birth should aspire.

Attractive influence or occult power being the reward of essential merit or true intelligence, the value of the advancing degrees of consciousness should be given careful consideration.

The attractive power of active animal consciousness is double that of the simple manifestation of the first degree of consciousness, and with self consciousness there comes treble power. For the individual asking in his own name for self alone a certain per cent of charitable humanity will give a favorable response with actual spiritual and material aid.

Were the individual to ask in the name of a family that he represents, he would add another degree of power to his plea. Were he to ask in the name and with the authority of the nation he represented, his plea would have additional power. Were he to ask in the name of humanity and the race, there would be even more response.

In the inspiration of the seventh degree where the angels beckon, from the innate hope of overcoming the "first death," humanity, even among the primitive races, has reverence for the one that has heard the "call" and from the extreme mind suffering and redemption emerges the victor from obsession or insanity.

Again free, there comes an even greater response when asking in the name of the Spirit of Life that is termed God.

If with the occult power of a Paul Revere you should ride your foam-flecked steed through the valley, shouting, "Fly for your lives," those hearing with comprehension would every one respond.

When the Absolute speaks and the "unchained elements" work their will in thunder, storm and earthquake, in clash of stars and suns, all things give way before the power of the Infinite.

An additional book could be written on The Chart of Mind, giving in detail the nature, power and privileges of each distinct step in viewpoint and advancing intelligence. Save, however, for one that has experienced the higher degrees of consciousness through psychic re-birth, there is difficulty in comprehending the actual power and spiritual emotion concomitant with the elevation of viewpoint.

Without action and a position in life requiring the use of transcendental powers of mind, there is difficulty of maintaining, except in exalted moments, contact with, or influx of, Absolute Consciousness. It is the opening or receptivity of the Finite to the Infinite that gives the consciousness of Oneness with the Invisible Presence and the growing feeling of irresistible power.

Consider yourself changing your occupation step by step until you experience the authority, intelligence and power of the different states of consciousness and reach the Occult sphere of Mastership—of the Lord God incarnate. You gain Family Consciousness and think of the interests of the household; then President of a Nation; a world Ruler; a Medium with access to the forces of so-called life and death; a Master Teacher of God Power; then with the influx of the Spirit, the Mediator between the Infinite and Finite.

Thus it is shown that the Medium is relieved from the enslaving elementals and disincarnate entities and wins the way to higher spheres with authority, intelligence and power magnified a thousand fold. And here you learn that you cannot climb up some other way, for without the conscious knowledge gained by experience step by step you could not be a genuine teacher and guide others with safety upon the True Way.

The first intelligent requirement is a new conception of the Supreme Being. Many writers have portrayed an Immanent God in plant and animal life, yet there are given in The Chart of Mind two conceptions of conditions of the One Infinite Substance beyond and superior to that we have termed God. The Master Man in joining the objective and subjective mind of his personality combines Art with Nature, in the sense that Nature builds and creates with atomic and electronic forces, while Art carves from the crystallized matter with physical force. Thus man in becoming the Natural Artist through the Divine Economy impels the forces of Nature to yield to his transcending vision, and is rewarded with improved animal forms, seedless fruits, and flowers of surpassing beauty and fragrance.

Triumphing in his temporary God Power and Lordship, he tends to forget the Invisible Presence of the True Supreme Being extending beyond the celestial hosts and

within and around all, whose very substance form science conceives to be the ether of space. There comes a time when we, conceiving ourselves to be thought forms in the depths of Absolute Consciousness, long for recognition from the Invisible Presence. To turn from the practical and material life to that which we sense with our spiritual perception is to lose hold on our present form of life itself. This is the danger concerning the material part. Yet a few have heard the Voice of the Infinite in Finite. and having faith for a few moments to obey, have with certainty held converse with the Absolute Consciousness of the Invisible Presence. Thus the mystery ends. for the individual spirit joining the Infinite Spirit gains the consciousness of victory and in the depths of Absolute Consciousness gains instantaneous transportation through the past, present and future of the realms of space.

After you have reached the Absolute Consciousness even for just one moment, you comprehend the purpose of life, and returning to materiality, make use of this freedom of soul flight to aid the ideal aim of the world surrounding the abode of your personality and thus justify the acquisition of this occult power of the mind and spirit.

It requires Faith to forsake all the desires of self in order to ascend to the Ninth degree of prescience and lasting Occult Power. The Chart of Mind gives you in an intelligent presentation the secret of the power and promise of all the prophets, avatars, and master teachers of the ages.

Daring to forsake all, there is nothing whatever lost; on the contrary, even like in the inspired words of old, you with certainty gain a thousand fold more in this life, even in your transformed and very personal desires, and the spiritual power concomitant with the material gain gives you faith in promise of glory in the life that is to come beyond the Great Change.

One goes just so far in theory and then you are required to give some time to aid others in order to increase your faith and gain the initiative which overcomes that indecision and self-hypnosis that paralyzes action. When you do not know what to do for yourself there is instant relief in doing something to aid others—and that is what all down through recorded history has been and is known by the mystic term—THE WAY.

Dropping all concepts of any system of morality---in the monistic concept, morality is the dualistic term for prescient knowledge-you formulate an ideal in harmony with the greatest possible intelligent foresight of what may be gained in both the material and spiritual world; then you mount to the absolute viewpoint, thence you see the very supreme mind working through you, wishes you to gain the very desires you hold, although you may notice in the Chart of Mind that following rebirth, Animal, Self. National and Dual Consciousness are omitted. This omission has been prophesied long ago by seer and poet, in Tennyson's Locksley Hall, when the "nation's airy navies" came there was to be "The parliament of mankind, the federation of the world," eliminating National Consciousness and overcoming the dictum of the "Peculiar People."

You will notice, however that Race Consciousness, in the sense of a Human Race, is maintained. The bugbear which the pseudo-idealists have for a while brought forward is what sort of a race this true race will be—white, black, yellow, or brown—or a mixture of all four. There seems to be quite a settled opinion in the minds of a few practical and prescient individuals out here in the West that it is not going to be a brown race!

Having some difficulty in entering the Ninth degree of Prescience, for practical purpose you may transpose this state of consciousness to the material world, and while from the viewpoint of present materiality you may be forced to admit that your "Kingdom is not of this world." there should be no difficulty in gaining a vision of a transformed material world when your long-delayed Kingdom should have come. And there are many loyal souls now who have faith that the spiritual Kingdom pictured two thousand years ago, in spite of all the wars and rumors of wars, is soon to be ushered into reality. Thus does the vision of the idealist remain even though "Heaven and earth may pass away." For in the depths of mind reigns the power of the ideal and it is written that if two minds agree touching one thing it shall be Thus we gain irresistible power when we gain a done. complete and conscious spiritual union with other minds concentrating upon a practical ideal.

Having gained with the objective aid of The Chart of Mind the conscious knowledge that the true aim of life is practical and true intelligence—prescience,—the awakened mind throws off the dominion of others and with new independence takes on the responsibility of directing his life toward a definite and desirable ideal. Yet were it well not to reject all bonds until you are certain that you have found the True Way. We may aspire to glimpse Omniscience in Omnipresent Law and through our knowledge of Law gain prescience within our sphere, yet we are required to recognize that beneath the Law there is a freedom of minor forces permitting individuality and initiative to aid in perfecting the Plan. It is this very recognition of Omnipresent Law that gives us freedom under the Law. Yielding to the Omniscient Law, we lose all fear and our aim becomes aligned with the Absolute Aim, and the latter, becoming personified in us, gives us a power before which the unorganized elements give way. Then we receive recognition and authority from on high to rule the elements within our sphere and to build according to the true ideals we hold.

Having gained the Mastery in our own sphere, we may aspire to higher spheres to which our faithfulness to the Law makes us eligible for promotion. Now from this viewpoint the Law is just the means whereby the One Perfect Plan may be realized, and when we rebel against the Law we thus delay the winning of the Ideal, and have not attained to true intelligence—prescience.

When we recognize that the Law is true intelligence it is involved in our being and we become its master and make use of it in ascending to higher spheres. Thus Faith, the Intuition of Truth, is replaced by conscious knowledge of Law, and with true intelligence and its concomitant increased energy we begin to make real the vision of the future.

To you the physical body with its intelligence is what is termed God. It has elevated you, an individual atom, to the position of ruler over the organized being, and wants you to make the most of your opportunity—to do something of merit. You are the Lord God over the universe of your body and if you aid your natural instincts with intelligent guidance you will have excellent health, a lovable nature and a poised mind.

You should learn sufficient of your environment and of the forces and entities about you in order that you

may be protected from danger and so comprehend your relation with others that you in your co-operation with the world may receive the favorable interest and aid necessary to win your true aims.

Life viewed from Absolute Consciousness is the endless mechanical changes of position of spiritual-material elements moving onward to the completion of some ideal aim.

More and more advanced minds are coming into agreement concerning the true aim of life and are working in unison to gain the ideal purpose, and in regard to its fulfillment on the material plane, the universal increase of knowledge among all active workers is the essential need. Therefore, if our work is writing, we in fulfilling this need offer some contribution to essential knowledge, something that will aid the world in its march onward toward the goal.

The world and the universe from the higher viewpoint being of itself the mechanical arrangement of a practical infinite number of atoms or particles, in the mind realm all things that do not involve a mathematical or mechanical contradiction are possible. The mind within its sphere, therefore, has potential omniscience through its ability to form with psychic elements any conceivable idea, picture, arrangement, action or condition of the universe of which it is an individualization. To think of some practical change, reformation, activity, or invention that will hasten the coming of the ideal and gain a response from others is an essential aim of life.

To make an algebraic formula intelligent to a mind untrained in higher mathematics it is necessary to restate it in arithmetic form, and likewise to make Truth known to primitive minds it is necessary to give concrete illustrations of our abstract reasonings.

Ideal thought is accompanied by unconscious clairvoyance or inner vision, and by discarding parable and vague abstractions one that is certain of the Truth may convey it to unprepared minds by using words giving a mind picture of the thought expressed. It is necessary that certain qualities be given to identify and make intelligent to others each element of our thought—its shape, size, relative place, action or non-action, and description of its nature; of intangible thought is required its relation or connection with, its action or dependence upon, tangible elements of thought, or other intangible thought.

A number of terms in general use have acquired a mystic or symbolical meaning through a lack of true definition. To gain ability to initiate action and to express what we desire. what we have termed Will Power is reguired, and to develop Will Power it is necessary to comprehend that Will Power in its practical and exact sense is just the conscious and loyal support of the plans, aims and decisions of the objective ego, given to it by the subordinate elements of mind throughout the body and brain, like the ethical and physical loyalty and support given to a king or ruler by his people. Therefore, the first essential in gaining strong Will Power is to take care of the physical and psychic needs of the physical and mind organism and to give just consideration and response to every lawful plea of the elements over which we rule.

To make practical superior and transcending intelligence it is necessary to have certain knowledge of the Laws operating in the subjective mind and in the objective expression. The First Law of Mind is the Law of Choice, that absolutely perfect and infinitely wise discrimination of intelligent consciousness which impels the individual to express from his viewpoint the highest practical ideal in each volition, to choose to do that which is to him the greatest apparent value or lesser injury to himself or his plans, and thus through the increase of the individual's intelligence aligning his aim with the universal aim, to impregnate the individual with Cosmic Sanity that he may be a direct and essential aid in the evolution of an ideal world and universe.

All sane, conscious beings being governed by the rigid First Law of Mind whose purpose is to project the Ideal, the measure of your mind superiority is shown by the extent of your ability to extend the sphere of your influence.

There are three ways of doing this: You may inspire the approval and co-operation of superior minds by adhering to the highest practical ideals; with mediocre minds that have not attained to high ideals. to gain their approval and co-operation it is necessary to know something of their character, the plans or purposes which hold their interest, that you may present to them more ideal plans, and by your superiority of mind with intelligent demonstration convince them that what you suggest will be of additional aid to them in attaining their aims; with inferior minds there will be difficulty of finding a common ground for meeting, while they keep their place they may to a certain extent be ignored. Where ignorance becomes aggressive, however, like weeds receding from the ideal, the true ideal requires protection, and the inferior plant is brought into judgment to be condemned or banished.

Once convinced that your aim is aligned with the Abso-

lute Aim, the projection of the Ideal, the objectifying and subjectifying of Omniscience throughout Omnipresence, it will require every resource of your intellect to gain the co-operation of others through aiding them to advance to the realization of their aims, purposes and ideals in such a manner that the True Aim will also be served.

The higher you aim, the longer you may confidently hope to gain the interest of others, and herein is found the very optimism of intelligence itself; and while you are required to be practical to gain results here and now, you should think seriously before you sacrifice your high aim just for temporary gain.

To be specific, you may aid others whose aims are not receding from the ideal, and to that extent give them what they want. When you have something more ideal than they have known, you should first present your proposition to those whom you have by previous investigation found open-minded for an interest in something better. This will save time and effort, and avoid disappointment, and the experience you acquire with those who may be presumed to look upon your proposition with favor will permit you later on to gain the interest of those, that without experience, you would find difficulty in approaching.

There is a possibility, however, that your aim may be in alignment with the Absolute Aim, and that you find yourself in an environment which is so aggressively opposed to the Ideal that there is no hope of gaining the cooperation of others. In proportion to your Faith in your Aim, there is a direct lessening of necessity of sacrifice, and unless you are indeed a prisoner of the enemy, you may feel free to change to another place where there is a

more favorable environment, or what many have found to be practical, may contact others at a distance with the written word or even send forth thought waves of ideal intelligence and receive a response from kindred minds at a distance.

Having gained a clear knowledge of the First Law of Mind and the correct way of coming into spiritual contact with others, there arises the necessity of Faith. Faith is the concomitant of that Intuition of Truth, that glimpse of the Omnipresence of Omniscience in Law which makes us serene and confident. Having acquired Faith in the Outer Infinity through the true intelligence gained in the elevation of viewpoint from our ascension to higher spheres of consciousness, we gain Faith in the Inner Infinity of our True Selves when the penetrating power of True Intelligence enters into the depths of our mind and reveals to us our unlimited possibilities of expression, for once the soul is opened to the Divine Influx of Absolute Consciousness there is inspiration coming without end.

Faith, before being transformed into conscious knowledge, is the certain sense we have of an inner wealth and ideality which insures our protection and the power of ultimate expression through the natural Law that ever aids the progress and fruition of Perfection. Conscious knowledge comes with realization and the certainty that within the fertile content of our mind new ideals are being born.

In the inner vaults of the soul there is a Treasure Trove, ever being added to by infinite hands, of which we have little dreamed. It is ours to use. And with every aid from body and brain we are gaining the power of expression.

One phase of spiritual unfoldment consists of awaken-

ing the dormant inner forces and connecting their mind content with the central consciousness. This is the dawn of inspiration leading to ecstasy and possible psychic rebirth of the individual ego. There is inspiration in the meditation upon Truth itself and the inner awakening is aided through contacting the aura of those existing in higher spheres of consciousness. In the exaltation of your mental tone the secret note signaling the coming of the inner day will be relayed to others within the sphere of your influence, and they, responding with the new song, give evidence of your occult power of initiation.

Gaining the viewpoint of higher spheres of consciousness will so change your mental attitude toward others, through the increasing intelligence giving you a sense of leadership overcoming all fear, that you will awaken an interest from unexpected sources and gain additional power and co-operation to aid you in winning your aims.

Your inner aim should be to so perfect the ideal for which you are seeking expression that all the inner and subconscious forces of your being will unite in harmony to aid in realization. For the most part the submerged power of your subjective self will act without your conscious knowledge, and all your objective knowledge is a mere pin-prick in comparison to the wealth of your subjective mind; the very nature of the unique position of the objective ego ruling over the external world compels concentration upon those facts and elements of mind which alone are necessary to sane judgment. Were all the wealth of the inner mind to come to the surface, the objective consciousness would be overwhelmed. Thus self-consciousness in the sense of retaining personal identity and individual viewpoint should be carried to higher spheres of consciousness, where it is shown that the individual welfare is predicated upon the alignment of the individual aim with the Absolute Aim.

A clear knowledge of the distinct degrees or spheres of consciousness shown on The Chart of Mind gives accessibility to the inner wealth, permitting increased mind action and unlimited variation of expression which, of itself, adds to the uniqueness and consequent attractive or occult power of the individual. Your Faith, strengthened by the conscious knowledge of the Truth Within, will prevent the depressing thoughts of others from impinging on your consciousness, and your constant optimism, even when an objective reason is lacking for exaltation, will ever protect you from the adverse influence of others and at the same time giving you a strong and inspiring reflex toward them, impelling a change of attitude favoring your aims.


THE NEW SPIRITISM



And the divine plan long shown in the heavens and reflected in the depths of the sea may ever have aided the monera in their evolution.




MONERON IN THE ACT OF REPRODUCTION

None may escape the touch of the Invisible Presence in the final world call to fulfill the divine plan. Trust and obey is the imperious order coming from the unseen, and millions weary with the trials of this life have passed on the higher spheres, while a few willing to obey remain to aid those in the spheres below to prepare for the spirit rebirth of man. And you that have obeyed, be it but for a moment, what glory and reward follows the crisis when you hear the unmistable voice of the Master Spirit saying, Thy faith hath made thee whole!

CHAPTER IX CLAIRVOYANCE

Clairvoyance, the inner vision with which we see the substance of thought, eliminates error in the operation of mind, the same as the outer sight enables us to avoid error in physical operations.

In the economy of mind, however, we also think with abstractions and rules which do not require the continual use of the inner vision to verify each process of thought. These rules might be likened to our mechanical laborsaving devices which automatically turn out a completed article.

But even a Master workman is required in emergencies to turn out work by hand, so the Master Thinker is required to construct and use the tools and rules of thought.

There is a way even in abstract thought of using words, which we call **logic**, in which we are just as certain of the correctness of our conclusions as we are of the results of a mechanical instrument of precision adding, multiplying and subtracting a series of numbers.

To have confidence in our refined mind processes and thus to economize in time that would otherwise be used for verification, we are required to be just as precise in the use of words as we are in using mathematical formulas having a definite and ascertainable value or meaning; to make our abstractions stand out clear before the inner 62 vision, in one instance we may refer to the simple meaning of words given in a standard dictionary, in the other we may reduce our algebraic formulas to arithmetic form.

While in both arithmetic and algebra the operation of addition is indicated by the plus sign, +, and that of subtraction by the minus sign, -, in algebra the plus sign acquires the new meaning of **positive**, producing or creative, and the minus sign, that of negative, consuming, or destructive.

To explain why the rule requires us to give the plus sign to the product of the multiplication of terms having the minus sign, while the result of the addition of terms having the minus sign is given the minus sign, that is to say, that while 3- plus 3- equals 6-, 3- times 3equals 9+, requires the application of clairvoyance with which we visualize a plus sign joined to a thought element having the power to create or produce an unit of quantity in an absolute time. Thus we see the operation of taking away three consuming elements at a time, three times, results in the taking away of nine consuming elements, which is equivalent, as far as net results are concerned, to the addition of nine producing elements. That is to say, in other words, if considering the minus sign to indicate the operation of subtraction or taking away, we take away three operations, or operators operating, if you cannot conceive abstractions, each taking away an unit of quantity in an absolute time, and repeat this three times, we have prevented the taking away of nine units of qualitity, which, therefore, results in their being nine units of quantity more than the quantity which would have existed had we not performed the operations.

Here we have written a clear explanation of how a rule is evolved and why the indicated result of its operation is inevitable. You could follow the rule and gain correct results, but that would not be true thinking, as an automatic machine could be made to do likewise.

In evolving a rule we gain a glimpse of Absolute Truth, or Law, the true element of Omniscience, from which we gain Prescience, the inevitable outcome of Law, and with Wisdom prepare for that which Prescience predetermines.

Evolving in our mind and establishing the certainty of the existence of Absolute Truth, or Law, our mind thinks the identical thought that Absolute Mind would think, or is thinking, under the same circumstances; thus we gain Absolute Faith in the ability of our mind to know Absolute Truth and come into the consciousness of the identity or Oneness of our mind with Absolute Mind.

With Wisdom we in no sense rebel against Absolute Truth, or Law, because it is just what we should arrive at were we given an unlimited time to think it out for ourselves; thus we welcome it as a revelation; we now know that an atom of Truth is added to objectified Omniscience—an Absolute Law with practical application is established, and we may confidently use the foreknown, inevitable results of its operation, and compile them once for all time for the use of others, as we have done in our tables of logarithms, where with the simple addition and subtraction of the logarithms of numbers the mathematician may avoid the drudgery of the more lengthy processes of multiplication and division.

With Clairvoyance our faith becomes sight and the re-

sulting conscious knowledge of Absolute Truth gives us an attribute of Eternal Power. Our minds with certainty now know.

CHAPTER X

CLAIRAUDIENCE-HEARING "VOICES"

"Then every part wherein My Spirit dwells Shall hear My Voice and know that It is God." —The Voice of God.

"Then conscience awoke like some torpid thing That is brought to life by the sun in the spring; And it lashed and stung him with poisoned thongs As memory brought him his train of wrongs." —Simon Grubb's Dream.

"And there were lightnings, and voices, and thundersings, and an earthquake, and great hail."—Revelation XI: 19.

From the time when Adam and Eve heard "voices" in the Garden (human body) of Eden to the time when Joan d'Arc, listening to "voices," led an army of her countrymen to save France from the enemy, and before the recent discoveries of the powers and faculties of the dual self, or subjective mind, many theories were advanced to account for the phenomena.

The "voices" were attributed to the Lord God, to the devil, to angels, spirits, fairies, and the irreverent skeptic went even so far as to suggest that the prophet had a flea in his ear. It should not be surprising that the subjective mind, having constructed the human speech apparatus, should have the faculty of speech itself.

Since the advent of modern Spiritualism the one experiencing the phenomena of "voices" is known as a Clairaudient. The sudden and unexpected coming of the "call" to one having no specific knowledge of the phe-66 nomena is overwhelming and dismaying. When the prospector in the desert begins to hear "voices," he concludes that it is about time for him to "pull his freight" and go where he may obtain the material and spiritual elements which the God Within is crying out for to maintain the wholeness of body and mind. When the athlete is trying to "weigh in' and begins to reduce even his muscle by training and fasting, and "voices" begin to thunder a protest into his inner ears, it is time for him to let up on exercise and return to more liberal rations. In the presence of unseen danger, disease, or even fleas or something worse, the "voices" are imperative in their demand for immediate action.

The Hindu holy man, enraptured by the "voices," will sit with his arm upraised and maintained in the same position for a score of years until the nails on his fingers grow through his hand. He has become "One with God" and he is taken care of and fed by those who reverence his devotion.

The practical mind of the Occidental adept demands a different kind of Mastership than the entrancement or self-hypnosis of the Oriental. True Mastership requires the ego to maintain a degree of objective consciousness during its subjective revelings in order to retain its connection with the outer world and be able to give to others the result of its illumination or communion with the subjective (spirit) world by recording its inner introspective experience in the objective brain cells.

If the voice within affirms that it is God speaking and must be obeyed, the ego, in order to maintain its sanity and control over the physical body, retains its integrity by affirming that the Ego itself is the Lord God with the inherent divine right to initiative and the direction of the objective life.

The "absent-minded" professor, through the continued use of his intellectual faculties in the solution of abstract problems, permits subordinate conscious centers in the brain to guide and initiate physical movements of the body, in order that he may think "the thoughts of God." He passes with safety along the crowded streets, seeing naught, feeling naught but the many thoughts within. This is a natural and normal mind development in which subjective brain cells are educated to perform a certain portion of the more or less automatic work of the mind requiring but a low degree of intelligence, and which only in emergencies call upon the real ruler for aid when the superior knowledge is required to combat the increasing difficulties of physical environment. Through overwork or injury to the central consciousness, the subordinate intelligence may in some little-understood manner be able to connect itself with the higher centers of consciousness. assuming complete control over the individual and exhibiting the phenomena of a new and widely different personality.

The birth of a new personality may be instantaneous and the original personality be entirely submerged, or there may be a gradual ascendency of the subordinate personality for years until the "cog in the wheel" life of the individual takes away from the original ego all initiative.

When the original ego becomes clairaudient, or assuming that it always has possessed the sense of hearing, when the subordinate center of consciousness acquires control over the cells of the brain connecting with the internal organs of hearing and thus becomes able to talk

with words to the central ego, the latter begins to hear "voices." This is the time when the rival mind centers become fully conscious of the existence of each other and the struggle for mind supremacy begins.

Here the monistic conception of being affirming the oneness of existence clears the mind from all superstition and the belief in the power of "evil," or its personification, the devil, and the duel of minds becomes one of wit rather than the opposition of purpose and so-called conscience, for true morality resolves itself into pure intellect and Prescience with its widening vision seeing the coming ideal of the whole is superior to the subjective vision or Wisdom of the individual.

It follows, therefore, that the objective ego with its faculty of inductive reasoning leading to Prescience is the natural and lawful ruler over the subjective ego, whose reason being limited to deduction, may only evolve Wisdom from the facts of memory and experience. It is only when the objective ego is enthralled by some ancient religious teaching, creed, or belief, and instead of being guided by the vision of the future searches for precedent and authority in the past, the natural realm of the subjective mind, that it endangers its mental throne by submitting to those laws tending to uniformity and repressing the uniqueness of the individual. Salvation comes in serving the ideal of the future and letting the dead past bury its dead.

CHAPTER XI

THE CHEMISTRY OF LOVE

The subject of this essay is that form or phase of **love**, which, in its incipient stage, may be superficially defined as that subtle attraction between the sexes, which obstinately impels an individual of one sex to select and unite with one of the opposite sex, and which becomes peculiarly intensified by the sight of a particular individual.

This form of love is a **compound** phenomenon and **has** no existence in reality save as an aggregate of the two fundamental and all-inclusive instincts of organized life, popularly known as Self-Preservation and Reproduction. Its stability varies with the proportion of its elements, and the cloud of poetical mystery surrounding the subtle compound (effect) disappears only upon its final resolution into its component parts (causes).

The chemist may resort to two distinct methods, analysis and synthesis, in determining the composition of any substance. By analysis a **compound** substance is separated into its component parts, which may then be identified. If we simply determine what elements enter into its composition without determining the relative quantities of these elements, we make what is called a **qualitative analysis.** If, however, we not only determine what elements are present, but also in what proportion they are present, we then make a **quantitative analysis**.

By synthesis the parts, or elements, may be artificially combined, so as to produce the substance under investi-70 gation. A synthesis, then, is the opposite of an analysis. Just as we may make a qualitative or a quantitative analysis, so also we may make a **qualitative** or a **quantitative** synthesis.

We shall first make a qualitative analysis of love, that we may discover its essential elements; then, by a quantitative analysis, determine the proportion of those elements in both the temporary and the permanent compounds. Finally, by repeated quantitative syntheses, we hope to determine in what proportion these elements must be combined and what subsidiary conditions are necessary to secure a perfect and permanent love.

Henry Drummond writes of love as follows in "The Ascent of Man":

"Love is not a late arrival, an after-thought with Creation. It is not a novelty of a romantic civilization. It is not a pious word of religion. Its roots began to grow with the first cell of life which budded on this earth. How great it is, the history of humanity bears witness; but how old it is and how solid, how bound up with the very constitution of the world, how from the first of time an eternal part of it, we are only now beginning to perceive. For the Evolution of Love is a piece of pure Science.

"Love did not descend out of the clouds like rain or snow. It was distilled on earth. And few of the romances which in after years were to cluster round this immortal word are more wonderful than the story of its birth and growth. Partly a product of crushed lives and exterminated species, and partly of the choicest blossoms and sweetest essences that ever came from the tree of life, it reached its spiritual perfection after a history the most strange and checkered that the pages of Nature have to record. What Love was at first, how crude and sour and embryonic a thing, it is impossible to conceive. But from age to age, with immeasurable faith and patience, by cultivations continuously repeated, by transplantings endlessly varied, the unrecognizable germ of this new fruit was husbanded to its maturity, and became the tree on which humanity, society and civilization were ultimately borne."

The original nature of the attributes, activity and effects of chemical elements varies widely, becomes neutralized, or may even seem to disappear entirely by becoming the very opposite while in combinations. Were we to examine the common chemical compound, water, without the aid of special electro-chemical apparatus, we would not be able to discover that its component parts, or elements, were oxygen and hydrogen, because these elements exist in liquid form only at very low temperatures. Water, having the power to attract and unite with additional oxygen, stops fire, the chemical action of gaseous oxygen.

There is an analogy of these phenomena in love, which identifies the latter as a compound, or effect, of spiritual elements. It is found in the fact that at the moment of experiencing this effect (love), its cause (elements), the instinct of Self-Preservation and the instinct of Reproduction, becomes transformed or inactive, and does not directly appear in consciousness. And even as water may stop the activity or fire of oxygen, so may the presence of love still the wanton ardor of the instinct of Reproduction in the free individual.

Peering now behind the phenomenon, man, that our senses may not be distorted by the illusive nature of things, and that we may discover the true character and

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source of the instincts of self-preservation and reproduction, we must keep well in mind the important fact that the human entity is but the effect, or form of the true being, and has no existence save as an aggregate of individuals—a confederacy of more or less conscious atoms with whatever electrical or other forces that have joined with them—organized as cells. It follows, therefore, that in these component parts lies the source of all the phenomena proceeding from the confederate body. A further examination reveals that certain highly conscious atoms have, through some innate superiority, become the "spirit" of, and acquired dominion over, the less conscious elements forming the more mechanical part of the confederacy.

For purposes of investigation we shall set out with a hypothetical postulate, which by many is accepted as axiomatic. If the atomic elements within the human body are endowed with immortality, certain conclusions are just and inevitable.

First, that the atom, of itself, its continued existence as an entity being predestined by an immutable law, and in nowise depending on harmonious co-operation and reciprocal support of other individuals, has no need of an instinct of self-preservation. It follows, therefore, that the instinct of self-preservation is not a primary law of being, but is manifest only in the mortal compounds of immortal elements.

Second, that, in order of obligation, the welfare or desire of the elements takes precedence of the welfare of the confederacy. It is true that one general desire of the elements is to perpetuate the existence of the confederacy, which necessitates the subordination of the individual desires of some of the elements to the welfare of the whole. And here is shown an instance of our former inverted perception; for in a certain sense the selfishness of the instinct of self-preservation, manifest in the aggregate, is revealed as the altruistic self-sacrifice of the true being -the ruling individual elements. Although, where the sacrifice is voluntary, it must be the desire held by a majority of the ruling elements. This conclusion is confirmed where the ruling elements have the more complex and far-reaching desire which becomes manifest in the aggregate as the instinct of reproduction, and which necessitates that the preservation and prosperity of the confederacy must, in a variable degree according to circumstances, be subordinated to the desire of the ruling elements, where the two conflict. And here we find another instance of our former inverted perception, as the altruism of the self-sacrifice manifest in the aggregate, while under the influence of the instinct of reproduction. is shown to be but the selfish gratification of the desires of the true being-the ruling elements.

As the result of the division of labor among the ruling elements of the evolving life form, there arose that highly organized body of conscious atoms within the cerebral cortex, known as the **objective mind**. For its use there evolved, and it became its chief function to control, certain subsidiary organs and accoutrements, that it might more successfully combat the increasing exigencies of physical environment and become a special aid in the work of nutrition and self-preservation.

How important has become the work of the objective mind, how mighty its achievements for the individual and the race, the many and amazing evidences of its handiwork, scattered throughout the world, abundantly testify. From its humble birth in a primitive cell of protoplasm,

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it steadily and so largely has increased the sphere of its intelligent activity, that now, incarnated in the highly organized creature, man, it not only has solved those problems of offense and defense in its immediate environment, but, with intricate devices of its own contrivance, peers into the far-off depths of space and ascertains the elementary composition of suns so enormously distant that thousands of years are required for their light to reach our planet.

But what has this "star-gazer" lost by over-specializa-When it awakens into self-consciousness in the tion? child, it finds itself suddenly promoted to a higher office and at the head of a body of atoms already conscious and in organized action, and over which it in time gains a limited rulership. It cannot, however, of its own volition, move a single involuntary muscle; it cannot directly hasten or retard an assimilative or vegetative process: and in the normal individual it is not even aware of the psychic activity of its companion self, the subjective ego, while the latter is planning and directing the subjective activities of the confederate body. It is for this reason compelled to yield under certain circumstances to those impulses from subjectivity concerning whose purpose it may have no direct knowledge. And it is only when the objective ego has knowledge transcending that of the subjective atom from which the impulse (instinct) proceeds, that it may undeceive the latter in critical moments and prevent its untoward expression.

It is the conscious union of the objective and subjective minds that produces Mastership, and this is the true aim of advancing intelligence. But until the normal subjective ego makes use of those faculties which investigate external phenomena and gains the powers of induction and at the same time make its wealth of memory accessible to the objective ego, Mastership is impossible. Thus in all save the Master, instinct and the compound, **Love**, is **blind**, because coming from the normal subjective mind having no powers of induction, it is reached by deduction alone, being merely a **law** arising out of more or less limited ancestral intelligence, precedent is its authority and guide, and while under certain circumstances its general operation may be beneficial, it is evident that circumstances may arise when it needs the eyes of objective intellect to save it, in its blindness and delusion, from abortive and undesirable manifestation.

While it is evident that the elements of love are an eternal part of life, the instinct of self-preservation and that of reproduction, operating separately, resulted in "crushed lives and exterminated species." And even now the crude compounds we term love do not assure the salvation of the race.

In showing that the various forms of sexual relations are instincts, Eduard von Hartman presents the following illustration:

"A widowed eagle," says he, "usually continues unmarried for the rest of her life. It was observed that a stork sought its female, which it could not take with it on account of a wound, every spring for three years, but in the following year remained with her, even during the winter. In monogamic animals sometimes the one cannot live without the other; thus, e. g., of a pair of inseparables, the second often dies a few hours after the first. The like has sometimes been observed of the Kamichi, a South American marsh-bird, as well as of turtle-doves and Mirikian apes. Woodlarks can only be kept in a cage in pairs. We cannot suppose that that which has overcome the powerful migratory instinct, which kills inseparables in a short space of time, is anything else than instinct; otherwise it could not so speedily and profoundly affect the being's core. That the various forms of the sexual relations are instincts is also proved by their unchangeableness within the limits of the species. According to the analogy of these phenomena, we must even in the case of man regard the cohabitation of spouses in marriage as an institution of instinct and not of deliberate consciousness, as also the tendency to found a family, which is closely connected therewith. The intentional pursuit of illicit transitory love we must, on the other hand, regard as something contrary to instinct, which is only called forth by conscious egoism. Here, however, I do not understand by marriage the ecclesiastical or civil ceremony, but the intention to make the relation a lasting one."

Quoting freely from Schopenhauer's "Welt als Wille und Vorstellung," Vol. II, chapter 44, Metaphysics of Sexual Love, Von Hartman recites the sole possible answer to the question: "What is the significance of that unconscious purpose? What is the meaning of an instinct, which calls forth such an obstinate selection in sexual gratification, and how is it furthered by the sight of just this particular individual?"

Says he:

"The instinct of love provides for a composition and constitution of succeeding generations corresponding as far as possible to the IDEAL of the human race, and the dreamed of bliss in the arms of the beloved one is nothing but the deceptive bait, by means of which the Unconscious deludes conscious egoism and leads to the sacrifice of self-love in favor of the succeeding generation, which conscious reflection could never effect by itself. It is the same principle, in special application to man, which Darwin subsequently established in his theory of natural selection as general law of Nature, namely, that the ennoblement of the species is brought about, in addition to the succumbing of the more unfit specimens of the race through the struggle of existence, by means of a natural instinct of sexual selection. Nature knows no higher interests than those of the race, for the race is related to the individual, as the infinite to the finite. Just as we demand of the individual that he consciously sacrifice his egoism, nay, his life, to the welfare of the whole, so does Nature with far less hesitation sacrifices egoism, nay,, the life of the individual to the welfare of the race through the medium of instinct (think of the maternal animal which does not shun death to protect its young, and the male in the rut, which fights even to death for the possession of the female). This can certainly only be called wise and motherly. We compel the conscious sacrifices of the individual through fear of punishment; Nature is kinder, she compels them through hope of reward. That is certainly more motherly!

"The description in detail of the way in which the bodily and mental qualities act on the Unconscious, and excite the unconscious will to beget this particular new human being which must result from the intercourse of these individuals, has been given in a masterly manner by Schopenhauer. I refer to the chapter cited above, and only give here a short abstract for completeness' sake. Two prime factors are to be distinguished: (1) Individuals exert a greater sexual charm the more completely they represent corporeally and mentally the IDEAL of the race, and the more nearly they approach the acme of the pro-creative power; (2) that individual has the greatest sexual charm for any other individual which, as far as possible, neutralizes the latter's defects by opposite defects, thus producing a child which represents the type of the race in the greatest possible perfection. One sees that under the first head will come the bodily and mental attractive force of symmetry, beauty, nobility and grace, to cause the awakening of sexual love, and one also now understands how it comes about, namely, by the circuitous path of an unconscious final causality, whilst before it was not at all evident how bodily and mental excellence could have anything to do with sexual love. The influence of age is likewise explained by the acme of procreative power (18-28 years for the woman, 24-36 for the man). As another example, I may instance the powerful charm which a voluptuous female bosom exerts on the man; the medium is the unconscious idea of the abundant nutrition of the new-born child. A powerful muscular frame (e. g., calves) also promises a powerful constitution of the child, and thus exerts a considerable charm. All such trifles are most carefully reviewed, and people talk about them with an air of importance, but no one reflects what an insignificant more or less in calves and bosoms have to do with the sexual pleasure.

"The first point contains the reason why, generally speaking, the individuals with the most perfect mental and bodily constitution appear most desirable to the other sex; the second point, why the same persons appear to have very different attractive power for members of the other sex, and why totally different natures are the most captivating of all. Both points may be anywhere put to the test, and they are found confirmed in the smallest details, if only a deduction be always made for what is not desired and wished for from immediate instinctive sexual inclination, but from other rational or irrational conscious motives. Tall men prefer short women, and vice versa; thin, stout; snub-nosed, long-nosed; blondes, brunettes; the intellectual, the naive; always, be it understood, only in sexual relations. Aesthetically, people do not generally find their polar contrasts beautiful, but their doubles. Many tall women will also, from vanity, refuse to marry a short man. It is clear that the sexual pleasure rests on quite other suppositions than the practical, moral, aesthetic and agreeable, which explains the passionate love for individuals whom the lover in all other respects cannot help hating and despising. Truly passion in such cases does all that is possible to dazzle the calm judgment, and to attune it in its favor; it is therefore decidedly correct that there is no sexual love without blindness. The disillusion which occurs on the decline of passion essentially contributes to strengthen the conversion of love into indifference or hate, as we even find the latter frequently at the bottom of the heart, not only in amours, but even among married people."

True love should have an equal proportion of both instincts. Representing the instinct of self-preservation by Sp, and that of reproduction by **R**, in Spiritual Chemistry we may write the formula representing the union of two individuals in true love, Sp_2R_2/Sp_2R_2 .

The travesty, tragedy, and comedy of present day love is entirely due to an excessive proportion, or lack, of either or both of its elements.

The travesty of love in the many barren homes where no glad voices of children break the unnatural silence, where the efforts of the aspiring element of love are ever

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abortive, where the ghost is finally yielded up at the demand for alimony, the unsavory odor arising from the fermenting compound upon its untimely dissolution in the divorce court, is self-evidently, entirely due to the prepondering proportion of the instinct of self preservation, and a lack of the instinct of reproduction, $\text{Sp}_3\text{R}_1/\text{Sp}_3\text{R}_1$.

On the other hand, the tragedy of love as shown in a hell—called home—where a nervous wreck of a woman, surrounded by ten or a dozen pale-faced and scantily-clad children, trembles at the return of a licensed monster who insists upon a further increase in family, already larger than he can properly feed and clothe, the needless bearing of inferior children of which one-half (praise God, the natural law!) never reaches maturity, the untimely bier and shroud for the woman whose life is paid forfeit for her too loyal obedience of Paul's injuntions: "Wives, submit yourselves unto your husband as unto the Lord," is self-evidently entirely due to a preponderance of the instinct of reproduction, and not enough of the instinct of self-preservation, Sp_1R_3/Sp_1R_3 .

We may see the comedy of love, where, as the result of the exhaustibility of variety, the uniqueness of the individual with its concomitant sexual charm, disappears. The individuals of this class, being repelled by the unique individuals, whose passion, according to the laws of sexual affinity, is greatest for natures entirely opposite, seek consolation in "marriages of convenience," or an unfruitful "free love"—frequently both—among themselves. Thus it is that individuals become "common" because they belong to a too common type, where the essential elements of love are almost entirely lacking, SpR/SpR.

To balance and control these instincts it will be neces-

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sary to bring about conditions permitting their union in true love. The reproductive instinct is no more or less than the voice of conscious atomic entities or sexual cells crying out for greater liberty and authority-for permission and assistance in their desire to become incarnated as the egos of new beings. Now it is theoretically selfevident that directly a conscious germ cell becomes aware that under certain circumstances leaving the parent organism necessitates certain destruction, it will no longer desire expression at that moment, but rather shrink back from that Rhadamanthine fate to which in its delusion it had been blindly hastening; this revulsion of feeling within the psychic content of the germ entity, welling up into the central consciousness of the parent organism, would, and in actual practice does, cause the latter to feel an abhorrence for that which it formerly desired.

Any individual with intelligence sufficient to read this essay understandingly may, by positive and concentrated thought, bring his instinctive nature into a state of complete submission and amenability to his intellect, where the conditions are such that were the instinctive impulse allowed expression at that moment its true purpose must be abortive.

Will being a compound of conscious and unconscious knowledge, intellect and instinct, it is due to ignorance alone, the lack of intellect, that man's boasted and transcendental "will power" is impotent and has permitted the instincts of self-preservation and reproduction to run riot until he has become money-mad and sex-mad a slavish subject to appetite and passion.

Salvation comes with conscious knowledge. In the qualitative and quantitative analysis of Love and Will, and their respective artificial qualitative and quantitative synthesis from their spiritual elements, we have discovered and established a process of subjugating untoward manifestations of instinct by the transcending power of intelligence, and given another proof of the absolutely perfect and infinitely wise operation of the Law of Choice in impelling the conscious and intelligent atomic entities of the human organism to choose to do that which is for the greatest apparent value or lesser injury for themselves or their plans. Again is our faith reassured, for the operation of the Infinite Intelligences is a revelation of the Omnipresent Divinity.

CHAPTER XII WHAT IS POSSIBLE?

"No mortal yet has measured his full force. It is a river rising in God's thought And emptying in the soul of man. Go back, Back to the Source, and find divinity. Forget the narrow borders and ignore The rocks and chasms which obstruct the way. Remember the beginning. Man may be And do the things he wishes, if he keeps That one thought dominant through night and day, And knows his strength is limitless, because Its fountain-head is God. That mighty stream Shall bear upon its breast, like golden fleets, His hopes, his efforts and his purposes, To anchor in the harbor of success."

What is possible? What is the expectancy of mental power? To what end and aim may man legitimately aspire? The ancient philosophers confidently affirmed that, "Everything which is, is agreeable to reason." Verifying again and again the inerrancy of our predecessor's deductions in reaching this particular broad conclusion, the conviction becomes further impressed upon our consciousness that everything which has been or ever will be--past, present and future being but one eternal now --must also be "agreeable to reason."

All cognizable phenomena of being leads directly to the conclusion that infinitude in its great totality is but a more or less ordered multiplicity of homogeneous and heterogeneous differentiations of the One Essential Entity 83 existing in endless permutations and combinations; the various combinations and groupings differing from each other only in size, form, number, motion and relative place.

While this idea of infinitude is but a mathematical conception of an endless multiplicity of mechanical elements partaking of the One Essence, it becomes enlivened by the now almost universal conclusion that every element of the All, the small as well as the great, partakes of the essential divine attributes of the all, sentience, will and spontaneity.

Given now a multiplicity of elements possessing consciousness, choice and the power of differentiation, attraction and repulsion, what can be impossible? Evidently only that which is self-evidently impossible mechanically and mathematically.

Therefore, it would further appear that with the All-Inclusive and Eternal Entity, all thinkable things are possible; in other words, from the infinite viewpoint, there being no dividing line, no distinction, between subjectivity and objectivity, theoretical possibilities are practical possibilities, for the substance of the subjective or microcosmic realm of thought of which the mental creatures are formed has an existence just as real as that which composes the objective entities of the macrocosm; "As is the outer, so is the inner," is axiomatic.

While a number of Advanced Thought philosophers are pleased to affirm that the mind of man is illimitable, in the next moment they declare it veritable nonsense to entertain the thought of man ever controlling the rainfall, causing storms to abate, or effecting a change in the course of nature. Yet why should these things be declared impossible if there is no limit to the expansion of

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man's mind? Why should not the ever-increasing intelligence of man ultimately empower him to consciously direct the lesser operations of Nature? We have no evidence for the assumption that the inherent instincts of the "unchained elements" are immutable; it is possible that they may, sooner or later, become semi-organized and amenable to the "reason" of man.

What may be a future reality is aptly anticipated in Samuel Johnson's famous masterpiece, "Rasselas," where the mad astronomer, after much hesitation and deliberation, takes into his confidence Imlac, who, with the Prince, is touring the world in search for happiness.

"'Hear, Imlac,' said the old astronomer, 'what thou will not without difficulty credit. I have possessed for five years the regulation of the weather, and the distribution of the seasons; the sun has listened to my dictates. and passed from tropic to tropic by my direction; the clouds, at my call, have poured their waters, and the Nile has overflowed at my command; I have restrained the rage of the dogstar, and mitigated the fervors of the crab. The winds, alone, of all the elemental powers, have hitherto refused my authority, and multitudes have perished by equinoctial tempests, which I have found myself unable to prohibit or restrain. I have administered this great office with exact justice, and made the different nations of the world an impartial division of rain and sunshine. What must have been the misery of half the globe, if I had limited the clouds to particular regions, or confined the sun to either side of the equator?'

"'How long, sir,' said Imlac, 'has this great office been in your hands?'

"'About ten years ago,' said the astronomer, 'my daily observations of the changes of the sky led me to con-

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sider whether, if I had the power of the seasons, I could confer greater plenty upon the inhabitants of the earth. This contemplation fastened on my mind, and I sat for days and nights in imaginary dominion, pouring upon this country and that the showers of fertility, and seconding every fall of rain with a due proportion of sunshine. I had yet only the will to do good, and did not imagine that I should ever have the power.'

"One day, as I was looking on the fields withering with heat, I felt in my mind a sudden wish that I could send rain on the southern mountains, and raise the Nile to an inundation. In the hurry of my imagination I commanded rain to fall, and by comparing the time of my command with that of the inundation, I found that the clouds had listened to my lips."

"''Might not some other cause,' said Imlac, 'produce this concurrence? The Nile does not always rise on the same day.'

"'Do not believe,' said the astronomer with impatience, 'that such objections could escape me. I reasoned against my own conviction and labored against truth with the utmost obstinacy. I sometimes suspected myself of madness, and should not have dared to impart this secret but to a man like you, capable of distinguishing the wonderful from the impossible, and the incredible from the false.'

"'Why, sir,' said Imlac, 'do you call that incredible which you know, or think you know, to be true?'

"'Because,' said the astronomer, 'I cannot prove it by any external evidence, and I know too well the laws of demonstration to think that my conviction ought to influence another, who cannot, like me, be conscious of its force. I therefore shall not attempt to gain credit by dis-

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putation. It is sufficient that I feel this power, that I have long possessed, and every day exerted it."

While from our limited viewpoint it may often appear that the thinkable is unattainable, yet, correctly speaking, to say that there are things thinkable that are impossible, is self-contradictory, for a thing thought is a thing in itself.

It follows, therefore, that while the transcending nature of mind enables us to form concepts, mental images, or conditions of being which we are not at the moment capable of projecting into objectivity, there is no justification in that dogmatism which declares the impossibility of the ideal; the extreme conservatist should, at most, only say that at present the ideal is impractical, which is to say, that it is mathematically possible, but as yet unrealizable, because of heterogeneous elements lacking unity of purpose.

Now if every individual upon any plane should come to realize the great, if not the greatest, truth, that there can be no **individual** good which is not at the same time **universal** good, in that moment of realization those individuals would gain a unity of purpose, which, upon expression, would project the ideal—the welfare of the whole.

If the sap beneath the bark of the hazel branch, influenced by some subtle telepathy, starts quivering and tingling in our hands as we bear it across the unseen stream of water flowing deep in the earth, is it all unreasonable to conclude that those highly-conscious atomic entities organized within the brain of man are influenced by and in turn influence the hosts of surrounding intelligence of the air, earth and water?

Does not Nature ever speak to her children? Does

not the poet hear the voice of the wood; the peasant, the message of the fields; the sailor, the welcome of the waves; the traveler, the silent oratory of majestic peaks?

Aye, the silent elements, each and all, forever speak to man!

And truly, many things there are which herald the time when man will interpret and speak the language of the Silent, and, gaining inspiration and power from his communion with Nature, bring into realization the long cherished Ideal, making all good and desirable things possible.
