Dr. Pierre Valjien's Perfect Numerology

In presenting this Textbook on the Science of Numerology for the use of beginners in this method of analysis of human life and endeavor, I shall try to set forth the principles in such simple language that there should be no excuse for misunderstanding or misinterpreting the rules.

Numerology, when applied to names of peoples, discloses the temperament of the person through the signature he or she uses; gives one an understanding of nature that operates to bring about personal experience and create conditions. It reveals the cycle of life, discloses the days, months of the year when one will go forward or backward; it shows the periods of hard struggle and points out the way to overcome opposition; it so develops one's intuition as to enable one to select the proper course to pursue in choosing a vocation that will result in one's success; also Numerology will indicate the name of the city and state in which you may live and enjoy health, happiness and business prosperity.

Not only does Numerology scientifically indicate and show the human path of destiny, but by the application of its rules one can trace the elements in the physical world from absolute substance to where they become lost to all trace of human consciousness and blend with the great infinite realm of Nuclei.

We are enabled to base a theory that the name of any thing, person, place, circumstance, law or principle can be truthfully analyzed and understood by the application of the rules governing word analysis herein.

If everyone in the world were engaged in the kind of work or profession that they love to do best there would be plenty for everyone and each one fitting into the place for which they were intended, all the world would be contented and all people would be in perfect peace with their neighbors, love, harmony, prosperity and happiness would be the common lot of all humanity.

That knowledge is of most worth which enables man to know the Infinite power of the Spirit that inhabits his body and gives him wisdom to control his thoughts and actions.

Rules

- Rule 1. The name should always be signed so that the Atomic Weight Digit is the same as the Soul Number Digit, when possible, or be in the same family of ODD and EVEN. A Number One (1) Soul Digit will harmonize with any Name Digit from 1 to 9, and a Number Nine Soul Digit will do the same; these are the two poles and all others must accommodate themselves to their respective places, 2, 4, 6, 8. Even Soul Digits call for Even Digit Names and 3, 5, 7, Soul Digits call for Odd Digit Names.
- Rule 2. The digit (2) appearing in any name followed by an even digit as 4, 6, or 8, indicates great trials in that nine year cycle. Should the 22 appear in any name it is a good indication that the evil threatening will be mastered. It is the master number.
- Rule 3. Positive Digits are 1, 3, 5, 7, 9. Negative Digits are 2, 4, 6, 8. Neutral 1, 5, 9. The nucleus is the Digit (5) both Infinite and Absolute. The unknown are 2, 6, 0. The symbol of the unknown quality is X 6.
- Rule 4. In changing a name do not change to a different Atomic Weight, if the birth name is the same as the Soul Number.
- Rule 5. In changing a name always aim to have the name digit the same as the Soul digit. This is not absolutely necessary in all cases, but they must be of the same family, odd or even.
- Rule 6. Never change the Atomic Weight digit of a name when it is the same digit as the Soul Number digit. Better change occupation or residence.

- Rule 7. To find the occupation that one should follow, take first the birthday digit, then the residence digit, then the name digit and add them together. Then supply a digit to make it nine. The digit thus supplied is the occupation number while the person is signing his name that way and living at that place.
- Rule 8. The names of Streets or the number and digit of residence is an immaterial thing.
- Rule 9. One may get success in many lines of business and in many occupations, when the established name of the business occupation or professions are the same digit as the person's name and soul number.
- Rule 10. Your Soul Number is ego intelligence brought into the world with you. Your name number is mental desires, so your birthday number is of the soul and your name number is of the body and mind. Soul makes desire.
- Rule 11. The birthday number, Soul number or birth path cannot be changed, but the name must be builded to conform concordantly with the Soul's vibration. See Rule 9. This is bringing the mental, physical, psychic and spiritual vibrations into concord and generates power.
- Rule 12. When the birthday digit comes by the addition of two negative digits, or a negative number, even though it be a positive digit, the person is still a negative character.
- Rule 13. If there be a birthday number composed of one positive and one negative digit, it gives them the characteristics governed by the first digit of the birthday or soul number.

MY SCHOOLING IN NUMEROLOGY

Many have asked me when and how I became a Numerologist. Here is the answer:

THE ORIGIN OF NUMEROLOGY

My education in the Science of NUMEROLOGY began at the early age of SIX in Central America. There, among the Sago Palms in the heavily verdured cliffs and shores, an unexplored region, familiar only to my forefathers, stands an ancient, silent MAYAN TEMPLE crowded with the Strange Wisdom of the Red Races. Interpretations of the symbols and Hieroglyphics of a first civilization dating back to the Continent Atlantis, unfolding pre-Biblical and pre-Historic facts, holding the lost secrets of Critolous, who completed a perfect NUMEROLOGY of which he was able to interpret the Great Principles of NATURE 800 years B. C. There is where I received my knowledge of this great science I am giving to you, dear readers, through the columns of my book.

Science has long recognized that the principle of VIBRATION is the infinite creative urge upon which everything depends for its SUBSTANCE and LENGTH of TIME of EXISTENCE. Where this law of vibration begins to create and where it ceases to function is what Scientists are devoting their most earnest efforts to. NUMEROLOGY is the KEY to this knowledge and supreme achievement of its use. How to unlock and solve the mysterious mathematical construction of the UNIVERSE. NUMEROLOGY began with TIME. The fact that the principle of mathematics underlies every Law of Nature is conceded by every thinking and reasoning person. We find in Ancient History the method or principle of mathematics is as old as history itself. Students of Egyptian, Greek and Anglo-Saxon languages have all been searching for centuries to discover the method of numbers known only in Pythagoras' time, which was some 200 years later than the period of the Great Master, Critolous.

PREHISTORIC SYMBOLS AND HIEROGLYPHICS OF THE AGES

In my Review of ancient history I found that the Chaldeans were the originators of mathematics taken from the stars.

PHARAOH created the first SYMBOL of WARFARE by chiseling a Statue of HIMSELF THRUSTING a SPEAR through the HEART of his ENEMY.

THE SPHINX is a symbol of the ETERNAL riddle of LIFE.

The first THOUGHT from the brain of MAN was transmitted to his fellow being by creating a SYMBOL suggesting his communication. The FIRST Alphabet given to the World was created from the THIRTEEN MOONS of the year. In the cut on page 8 is shown THIRTEEN symbols that singly or in combination form every DIGIT in mathematics, every LETTER in the ENGLISH ALPHABET, also the Roman numerals as well as every other character used in writing by any RACE. Far back in the Biblical Ages, thousands of years before the Birth of CHRIST, the fundamental components of letters and figures were the Vertical Miniature, Vertical, Left Diagonal, Miniature Diagonal, the Horizontal Miniature, Horizontal, the Right Diagonal, the Miniature Right Diagonal, the Left Large Brace, the Miniature Left Brace, the Right Large Brace, the Miniature Right Brace and the Left and Right Miniature Braces combined. From the use of one or more of the described symbols shown on page 8, the Nine Figures, the English Alphabet creates our words, our words create our sentences and sentences express our thoughts, creating our communication from one individual to another. Thus we have the Evolution of Education.

The makeup and character of every person is indicated in the assemblage of components representing his or her name and in any numbers by which he or she may be designated.

* The directional description of a person's character such as to say that they are upright, or on the level, on the square or low down, backward or straightforward, came from these characters. Letters composed mostly of upright and level lines represent the greatest degree of resistance to the Negative Outside Control. Some letters indicate waves of force of the ALMIGHTY, while others are pursued by the forces of evil.

The ten ancient character symbols shown above in the lower half of the cut represent each of the Heavenly Bodies of the Solar System and from these was conceived the Ancient Mayan Calendar which was later adjusted and perfected into their Present Calendar of Thirteen Months to the year, twenty-eight days to the Month and seven days to the Week, twenty-four hours to the day, sixty minutes to the hour and sixty seconds to the minute, which has proven accurate for centuries with a full moon on the first day of each month and has not missed the sixteenth part of a second since the days of the Master NUMEROLOGIST CRITOLOUS, 800 years B. C.

I hold under a THIRTEEN month Calendar each Planet will connect with its corresponding link in the grand chain of the UNIVERSE, as God Mathematically created it in the first place. Under this System there will be felt an outstanding influence for a Universal Brotherly LOVE and a World's PEACE. Prosperity and Happiness will be the common lot of all HUMANITY.

NUMEROLOGY is a Science older than the Ruins of EGYPT or INDIA. With the knowledge of how to apply it you can interpret the Highest forces of Nature. It will show Man, Woman, Boy or Girl what profession, Art, Business or Vocation in LIFE they are naturally adapted for. It will elevate Wayward Characters and show them how to use their TALENTS and RISE in the WORLD. Later on I will prove why William Edward Hickman, the Boy Murderer, and other Arch Criminals through NAME VIBRATION allowed their EDUCATION to SOUR on their STOMACH, denied GOD and fell Victims of predominating Negative Influences.

Numerology is more than an influence on individual lives and destinies. It plays a great and commanding part in the Universe itself. It is the one unanswerable argument for the adoption of what is called the thirteen-month calendar, a proposition now being studied in this and other countries. For many years I have written and lectured on behalf of the thirteen-month calendar. And here is why:

THE THIRTEEN-MONTH CALENDAR

GOD so constructed the Universe mathematically that man may know his work. As King Solomon said, "There is a Time and Place for Everything." The Sun is the Heart of the Universe, the Life-giver of all things. We have nine planets that circulate around the Sun. They are numbered according to their distance from the Sun. THUS: Mercury is the nearest known planet to the Sun, 3,030 miles in diameter, 36 million miles from the Sun and 59 million 9 hundred thousand miles from the Earth. The Moon, the Earth's

Satellite, is next, 2,160 miles in diameter and 239,000 miles from the Earth, traveling in space, making one revolution around the Earth every 28 days, THIRTEEN times every year.

It has been recognized for thousands of years that the Moon has power over everything on Earth, controls the Tides of the Ocean, Plant Life, the Rise and Fall of the Sap in the Trees, as well as the functioning of the Human Body. The EARTH is Third in order from the Sun. 7,917 and six-tenths miles in diameter, the Earth rotates once on its axis every 24 hours and revolves once around the Sun every year of 364 days, or 13 moons of 28 days to the Full Moon, creating the Four Seasons; Spring, 13 weeks; Summer, 13 weeks; Autumn, 13 weeks; Winter, 13 weeks—total 52 weeks to the year. I hold this is the Perfect Calendar according to the mathematical construction of the Universe.

Our present calendar is all out of tune. For this reason, the World is in such a state of Turmoil and Perplexity. In 1866 we had no full moon in February, and two full moons in March, thus proving the mathematical inaccuracy of our present calendar.

A thirteen-month calendar will adjust the prevailing unrest among the Nations of the Earth, and will be the outstanding influence for the World's peace. The planets have vibratory influence upon the Earth as they journey around the Sun. Venus is 7,700 miles in diameter, 67,200,000 miles from the Sun and takes 225 days to make one complete revolution around the Sun. At times Venus comes within 25,000,000 miles of the Earth on its journey. Venus is known as the God of Love, Harmony and Bliss. Artists, Designers, Musicians are born when Venus is in Taurus and Libra. Mars is 141,500,000 miles from the Sun and on its journey around the Sun comes at times within 35,000,000 miles of the Earth. Mars is known as the God of War.

WAR-MAKING PLANET

Every War in the History of the North American Continent began when Mars was in the Sign of Aries. Every war in any part of the Earth began where Mars was the closest to that part of the Earth. Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus and Neptune all have their influence on the Earth on their journey around the Sun. It takes Neptune, the ninth planet, 165 years to make one complete revolution around the Sun, or 60,060 days, and it is 2,698,800,000 miles from the Earth. Every 2,000 years Neptune, on its journey around the Sun, comes close enough to the Earth to be seen by the Naked Eye. The first record of Neptune seen by the Human Eye was at the Birth of Noah, the First Savior of the World. The second time was at the Birth of Christ, the Second Savior of the World. We are now living in the year 1930. In 70 years will be the year 2,000 and Neptune is coming closer to the Earth all the time. Neptune is the Planet of Wisdom and Inspiration. Twenty-seven of the World's greatest Geniuses were born under the Planet Neptune, and they include Alexander Graham Bell, George Washington and Luther Burbank. Numerically speaking, under a thirteen-month calendar, each planet will connect with its corresponding link in the Grand Chain of the Universe and can readily be interpreted by the use of figures and symbols proving how they are related to each other by the Science of Sciences, NUMEROLOGY.

All nature is made up of vibrations. Not a tree that grows, not a bird that sings, is without them. Even the modern miracles of invention, such as radio, television, talking pictures, are made up of vibrations. You are a creature of vibrations. Your name is a thing of vibrations. The Numerologist, skilled in an art that harks back to remote times across a span of many centuries, can, without seeing you in the flesh, record your characteristics by means of the vibrations which are calculated in your name, letter by letter, through the process of Numerology. It is a cold calculation

throughout. It is as exact as mathematics, and mathematics can not be a falsifier. Therefore, a Numerologist is by no means a mystic and practicer of hocus-pocus, but a mathematician, or Numerological calculator of vibrations according to established rule. There is never a varying path. The way is set for those who know.

You are ruled by temperament, mostly good or mostly evil and, on the average, mixed up in both good and evil impulses. I contend that the vibrations such as are discoverable by the processes of Numerology, dominate every human being. Try it for yourself. How shall you go about to determine this? Let us pretend, for instance, that you are named John Smith.

To obtain the number or vibration of any individual, take the sum of the atomic weight number of the name and divide it by the gross volume digit of the name and you will have the name's average number and, therefore, the temperament of that person. And this is important—be sure to take the name as it is signed daily, as, for instance, John Smith. For that is the vibration name and decides clearly the number under which the subject of the Numerological examination is to be judged.

There are Negative and Positive temperaments, as you all know. The Negative letters or digits are 2-4-6-8. Count the number of letters or digits in the name. If it has more 2s, 4s, 6s and 8s than 1s, 3s, 5s, 7s and 9s, then you can be sure the owner of that name is of a Negative temperament. If the name has more 1s, 3s, 5s, 7s and 9s than it has 2s, 4s, 6s and 8s, then you can be certain the owner belongs to the fortunate Positive class. And let us scan carefully the reasons why the Positive class is fortunate and the Negative class quite unfortunate.

Persons with the Positive temperament are Aristocratic, Intellectual, Firm, Earnest, Idealistic, Chaste, Agreeable, Creative, Loyal, Tactful, Self-Reliant, Inventive, Happy, Versatile, Noble, Intuitive, Thoughtful, Diplomatic, Fearless,

Patient, Poised, Scholarly, Dependable, Far-Sighted, Artistic, Magnetic and Economical.

Persons with the Negative temperament are Careless, Fickle, Lazy, Hateful, Cowardly, Miserly, Talkative, Jealous, Mercenary, Stubborn, Foolish, Clumsy, Boisterous, Lustful, Treacherous, Changeable, Sporty, Gossip-Loving, Gamblers, Nervous, Selfish, Mean, Dominating, Extravagant, Sneaking, Shiftless, Wily as a serpent.

How to Find the Right Occupation That Will Bring You Success

Take the alphabet and divide it in the following manner to get the numerical value of each letter:

The alphabet as shown above in this column is divided in a manner so as to bring forth the numerical value of each letter.

Each word may be reduced to its lowest numeral. For instance: If your first name is James, its numbers are 11451 or, added together, 12; or again added together, 3. This is the method of obtaining your Personality number, the signed name must be used.

The Soul number is obtained by adding the entire number of digits comprising the month, day of month and year born in.

The Residence number is obtained by adding the numbers representing the letters in the name of the town and state where one may reside.

The Occupation number is obtained by the same method.

It is thus arranged under a four-fold proposition, and the total of the four digits results in 9. Therefore the concord brings forth personal satisfaction.

Four Basic Principles of Numerology

In beginning this treatise on the Science of Numerology, and endeavoring to set forth rules for its application to all problems of life, we will give our reason for interpreting the value of certain digits or figures from one to nine and words that are represented by a single digit which will hereafter be referred to as the vibration of the word. I mean that each word has, when properly reduced to a single digit, a weight or power or vibratory force or expression that results in sound and is preceded or followed by a mental vision of the thing named or numbered.

Now take the alphabet and divide it in the following manner to get the numerical value of each letter:

The following rules must be observed very carefully in applying the Four Basic Principles of Numerology:

* I. **Gross Volume of a Word:** The total number of letters or digits of which it is composed. The single digit is placed over the word.

II. **Atomic Weigh of Word:** Is the total or final digit after the figures under each letter has been added together until by one digit remains, thus:

Example: **Word**

5694 equal 24 equal 6—

the Atomic Weight of Word is 6.

III. **Combined Power of a Word:** The combined power of a word is found by adding the Gross Volume Digit and the **Atomic Weight Digit** together, thus:

Example: **Word**

6 plus 4 equals 10 or—1.

the combined power of the word is therefore 1.

IV. **Origin and Destiny**— is the total number of letters or digits of which the whole word is composed and is found by counting the number of figures you have used in the deduction, thus:

Thus you have used 10 digits and these when added make 1, which is the Origin and Destiny of Word.

Do not count the 0 a digit. It is the symbol of the Infinite.

TEMPERAMENTS

There are nine DISPOSITIONS or TEMPERAMENTS. Temperaments are of the Ego but Dispositions are of the SPIRIT. As the Spirit wills the Ego orders and the Mind directs and the Body acts. And all action is by word.

As there are only four perfect numbers between 1 and 10,000, so there are only four perfect dispositions or temperaments in ten thousand people. The proportion holds good throughout all nature.

Now the perfect number between one and ten is six. The other one between ten and one hundred is 28; the one between 100 and 1000 is 496, and the one between 1000 and 10,000 is 8128.

A perfect number is a number that the sum of its divisors other than itself equals the number.

For instance, six is a perfect number because the sum of its divisors other than itself equals six: 6 equals 1 plus 2 plus 3, equals SIX. Twenty-eight in like manner: 28 equals 1 plus 2 plus 3 plus 7 plus 14, equals 28.

The three divisions of numbers are called ABUNDANT, Deficient and Perfect. Perfect number is 6 and 28; Abundant number is 12 and 24, and Deficient are 8 and 14. The PERFECT are between EXCESS and DEFICIENCY, as consonant sound between acuter and graver sounds. These are the names of persons and such persons' dispositions are interpreted from the sound of their name, which sound is produced by the number of the name and the number of the name holds the secret of the character and power of the individual bearing that name. The four perfect numbers, you will notice, have the property of ending alternately in six and eight.

GROSS VOLUME of a name is what the person is as a whole; it is the **TEMPERAMENTAL NUMBER**.

ATOMIC WEIGHT of a person's name is an index to their Desires and Ambitions.

COMBINED POWER of a person's name foretells whether the Ambitions and Desires will be realized.

ORIGIN and DESTINY of the name tells what the Desires and Ambitions of the person should be if they would have perfect—

Temperament

How to Find It by the Name

To get the number or vibration of the temperament of any individual, take the sum of the ATOMIC WEIGHT NUMBER of the name and divide it by the GROSS VOLUME DIGIT of the name and you will have the average number and that is the TEMPERAMENT of that person. Be sure to take the name as signed in daily work for that is the vibration name and decides the number under which they must be judged.

Negative letters and digits are 2, 4, 6, 8. Count the number of digits in the name. If it has more 1, 3, 5, 7, and 9's than 2, 4, 6, or 8's, then the person has a Positive Temperament; if more 2, 4, 6, and 8's, then it is a Negative Temperament.

TEMPERAMENT ARE:**

- POS: Independent, wise, studious, chaste, agreeable, kind, creative, pleasing, loyal, tactful, passionate, talkative.
 NEG: Negative, cowardly, miserly, tactful, talkative, jealous, independent, wise.

EITHER POSITIVE OR NEGATIVE, THE NUMBER TWO IS THE HARDEST CHARACTER TO READ.

**THOSE WITH A NUMBER THREE
TEMPERAMENT ARE:**

- POS: Self-reliant, inventive, happy, versatile, complacent, noble, intuitive, thoughtful, diplomatic.
 NEG: Mercenary, stubborn, foolish, sluggish, clumsy, boisterous, lustful, evil, traitors.
 In either case the Number Threes are very INTUITIVE.

**THOSE WITH A NUMBER FOUR
TEMPERAMENT ARE:**

- POS: Fearless, patient, enthusiastic, unemotional, neat, original, universal.
 NEG: Changeable, impetuous, roving, phlegmatic, unstable, receptive, flattering busybodies, lascivious, morose, impassive.

Either positive or negative the Number Four's mind is always busy planning either pleasure or misery for somebody.

**THOSE WITH A NUMBER FIVE
TEMPERAMENT ARE:**

POS: Energetic, liberal, generous, quiet, unemotional, poised, shrewd, sober, scholarly, clairvoyant, good students.

NEG: Sporty, patronizing, gossips, gamblers, beggars, languid, obdurate.

**THOSE WITH A NUMBER SIX
TEMPERAMENT ARE:**

POS: Peaceful, lovable, cheerful, reserved, dependent.

NEG: Nervous, capricious, selfish, abrupt, garrulous, insincere, rounders, mean.

**THOSE WITH A NUMBER SEVEN
TEMPERAMENT ARE:**

POS: Determined, witty, orderly, positive, stationary, speculative, thrifty, resolute, loving, decided, just harmonious, far-sighted.

NEG: Dominating, stationary, speculative, determined, secretive, decided, resolute, extravagant, stolid.

The number Seven temperament is composed of more individual traits and combinations than any other of the nine and there are scarcely any negative traits shown to the outside world; their evil they keep to themselves.

**THOSE WITH A NUMBER EIGHT
TEMPERAMENT ARE:**

POS: Courageous, ardent, intellectual, adaptable, resourceful, immaculate, powerful, pious, mediumistic, spiritual.

NEG: Irresponsible, imperious, unconcerned, impatient, sneaking, despondent, courageous, resourceful, powerful.

**THOSE WITH A NUMBER NINE
TEMPERAMENT ARE:**

POS: Gentle, poetical, artistic, placid, accurate, eager, economical, magnetic, dominant, zealous.

NEG: Haughty, mediocre, dominant, restless, moody, shiftless, impartial.

This concludes the most striking characteristics of temperament as defined by the digits from 1 to 9
PSYCHONUMERO Dr. Valjien's Perfect Numerology.

EXAMPLE

Take the name of

THOMAS A. EDISON—13—4 Gross Volume Digit
2 8 6 4 1 1 1 5 4 9 1 6 5—53 Atomic Weight Number

The Gross Volume Digit 4 is contained 13 and one-fourth times in 53. Thus:

The Only Way to Get Success

"The first thing to realize is that Success is positive, not negative. It consists in doing, not in not doing; in creating, not in preserving; in attack, not defense.

Definitions. To begin with:

Are you ambitious? Well, now, I expected that answer YES. You caught the word and answered on the impulse of the moment. Do you know that not one in twenty-five men or women know the meaning of the word AMBITION? It is a fact, they do not. Yet every day they go right along calling themselves ambitious when all they have is a desire for something. **DESIRE**: Yes, that is the word you should use nine times out of ten. There is as much difference between these two words as there is between SUCCESS and FAILURE, and you will find them descriptive of men and women in each of these two pathways of life.

Now, as a preliminary to this lesson "How TO GET SUCCESS" I am going to give you the true definition of AMBITION. When you have carefully considered it you will be able to grasp more readily the lesson points.

During the life of every person the DESIRE for success sometimes springs into an AMBITION.

Now mark carefully where these two words DESIRE and AMBITION appear in the foregoing paragraphs. DESIRE is first.

Read it over three times and consider it well, because upon your understanding of these two words may depend your SUCCESS or FAILURE.

DESIRE is NOT AMBITION. Don't get them mixed again. Note the definition:

DESIRE: That inactive faculty of mind that longs for something to satisfy the bodily need. That inward craving that grows into action, when perfect concentration has devel-

oped the will into initiative power to work out a plan of constructive creation of material things. Desire is the SEED OF AMBITION. Necessity is the mother of DESIRE and AMBITION is the result of continued desire.

AMBITION: Is intellect and will power united with spiritual and physical force intelligently directed and controlled into the modelling of things and conditions desired. Out of THOUGHT all things come.

Now, let me tell you How to Get Success:

In order to save your time and mine, I must be brief, plain and pointed in my talk with you.

You want SUCCESS. You want to know how to get SUCCESS. Listen; This is WISDOM boiled down.

Four essential things are necessary to attain SUCCESS.

The very first of these is to know what kind of Success you want. This is of the first importance. Do you know yourself what you want? Have you thoroughly considered the field you wish to enter. If you have, then you are in a condition of mind to lay the foundation upon which you must build.

This foundation is a clear mental picture of what you want. Can you see in the eye of your mind a mental perspective of what you DESIRE? Remember Desire is not the real power that will bring you SUCCESS. Almost everyone has a DESIRE for SUCCESS. Desire is only the fore-runner of AMBITION. In AMBITION is the power. Now, your DESIRE will cause DAY DREAMS and if allowed to fade out without action these days of GOLDEN OPPORTUNITY will glide down the river of wasted time and bring you no nearer SUCCESS than you were before you dreamed. But take up with yourself seriously the use of time. Out of time everything comes and as time after time the DESIRE comes to you for SUCCESS cause this desire to flow in one continuous thought toward the permanent mental picture of your SUCCESS (that is to be), and then your AMBITION will arouse itself some day and regenerate your whole world

of activity. Ambition awakens all the power in one's nature to bring into reality the thing one wants and knows how to define and construct. You will never go farther than your imagination takes you. You will never have any greater SUCCESS than you feel you are justly entitled to. You will never be given any more than you demand. You will never have anything permanent until you build it out of your own material, with your own brains and hands and demonstrate your power to have and to hold. First thing necessary then to get SUCCESS was DESIRE. The next thing was AMBITION.

Ambition is stored up power when not wasted. Ambition only works efficiently when it is secretly working. This is a caution to plan your work carefully—work out your plans quietly and never tell your plans to any one, and only to superiors such parts of your working plans as are necessary to retain their confidence. Results are what managers and owners want, is what you want. Not talk.

DESIRE, AMBITION, WORK, STICK-TO-IT-IVENESS.

These are the first principles. These four fundamentals are the solid rock upon which all Success of any known degree is builded. No other way to get it. You must know what you want. Know where it is. Devise a plan for getting. THEN THINK WHILE YOU WORK.

Desire for a thing then causes a dream of enjoyment in anticipation of possession.

DESIRE then becomes AMBITION which is strong with DETERMINATION.

DETERMINATION is developed into action and work begins.

Then THE WAY TO GET SUCCESS, which is entering into possession of the things you desire is: DEFINE IN YOUR OWN MIND WHAT YOU WANT. LOCATE IT, THEN GO AFTER IT.

But before you start get wisdom.

How sad is the lot of the "square peg in the round hole," and vice versa! The born mechanical genius whose neck is girt with a cruel starched collar and who is doomed to slave away his days in a bank! How pitiable! It seems that in his boyhood his mama wanted him to have a "well-dressed career," and so forced him into a bank and into lifelong misery, for there is never to be for the poor fellow the paradise of engines and machinery, the field of mechanical invention.

Too late, now, perhaps, to enter his real life work. A white-collared slave in a bank who might have achieved the eminence and fortune and happiness of "the square peg in the square hole." I can read between the lines of many of my letters and their pleas for help through the process of Numerology, and my heart leaps in sympathy with many of my correspondents. And there is the genius-in-embryo who never had her real chance, because of the specter of poverty, and is working in a laundry when she should be writing books! They cry out to Numerology for help in their uneasiness and vague distress. Yes, my friends, I read between the lines, as the saying is, even as I calculate the exact balances of the vowels and consonants in the names of people and things, and the relation thereof to Numerology.

Other born geniuses know definitely they are misplaced or retarded, but know not the reason why. There is, for instance, the violet is lovely in its nook of humility, but it gets nowhere. The Sphinx is massive, but silent. Tells nothing of itself. And so has gotten nowhere; never, never will get anywhere. Be wise! Be bold! Be not afraid to stand in the world as your own trumpeter, Mr. Genius-in-Embryo.

Numerology is not a new invention. It was practiced centuries before the Three Wise Men, the Magi, were guided by the star to the stable where lay, in a manger, the Infant Jesus. Long before Tacitus wandered through ancient Germany, Numerology was an art. It has been my art, too, for many years and may be your help and staff, too, for many years to come.

You, by means of my alphabet and numbers table above, have mastered the first principles of Numerology. You know that the letters designated by the numerals 2, 4, 6, 8 are Negative and the letters designated by the numerals 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 are Positive.

LESSON No. 1

To obtain the number or vibration of the temperament of any individual, yourself or friend, take the sum of what we call the atomic weight number of a name. Let us suppose you are named Tom Jones. T is the numeral 2, O is 6, M is 4, J is 1, O is 6, N is 5, E is 5 and S is 1. You will notice Tom Jones has a name equally divided between Positive and Negative letters. Add them up and you have the sum of 30. Divided by the Gross Volume $8 = \text{Three and Six-Eighths}$ added thus $3 + 6 + 8 = 17 = (8)$. Therefore, Tom Jones' name sums up as 8—Neutral. He is equly divided between good and bad, between benevolence on one hand and selfishness on the other. He has a most lovable disposition. He can be as fierce and uncompromising as a tiger in one moment and be melted to tears of compassion in the next. He always is interesting in his storms or in his sunshine, for he is evenly balanced Numerologically, so far as his name goes, between the Negative and the Positive. Four Negatives and four Positives will be found in the eight letters comprising the name of Tom Jones, if you will notice. For the gross volume of a name indicates the temperament. The atomic value of a name is an index to the desires, the ambitions, the power for good or evil in a person. So in order to adjust Tom Jones' signature to a positive tempera-

ment and to a more valuable personality number, sign his name Thomas Jones. Giving him six Positive Letters and five Negative letters. This gives him a number 2 positive temperament. Independent, studious, chaste, agreeable, creative, loyal and tactful. Study well the value of your name, either as it was given you in baptism or was adopted by you later, as your daily signature.

Squeaks in Name Brings Squawks in the Homes

I am taking the inharmonious "squeaks" out of personalities by showing how, with a simple change, a name-owner can achieve the harmonious "clicks" in his names, and therefore in his personality, by the process of Numerology. I want every one of you to study the simple alphabetical-numerological table. It is the first step in Numerology and you can use it well as a sure guide in your calculations. Commit it to memory.

LESSON (2)

Your soul number is Ego! Intelligence brought into the world with you!

Your destiny number is the atomic weight value of your name, your mental desire. The gross volume of your name, plus the atomic weight value, is body or physical qualifications.

The atomic weight value of a name divided by the gross volume number will equal, reduced to the lowest digit from one to nine, the exact temperament of that person. Negative or Positive. In order to find out if Negative or Positive, total the number of Negative digits and the total of the Positive digits. If the deduction equals 1, 3, 5, 7 or 9, that person has a Positive temperament, number whatever digit the deduction equals, and if the deduction equals 2, 4, 6 or 8, that person has a Negative temperament, whatever digit the deduction equals.

The method of obtaining your personality number is to take your given name or the initials used in your signature. The atomic weight value will equal your personality number.

Example: Henry=85597=34=7 is the personality number (Positive).

Example: Wm. F. 5 4 6=15=6 (Negative personality).

Now Wm. F. may have a family name so that his signature gives him a Positive temperament which predominates his personality number. Thus, after knowing Wm. F. for some time, you discover many very desirable Positive traits and you find him dependable. On the other hand, Henry has the Positive personality and you are greatly impressed with Henry. Now Henry's family name reduces him by a numerical deduction to a Negative temperament, and you discover on further acquaintance that Henry is possessed with many unpleasant Negative faults; unreliable.

LESSON (3)

In the science of Numerology each name or word has, when properly reduced to a single digit, a weight, power or force of expression that results in sound and is preceded or followed by a mental vision of the thing named or numbered. So we have in all our figures just nine degrees of vibratory forces. No matter how many figures are bound together, they have an atomic weight value from one to nine, which is the atomic weight or number vibration of that word, name, place, principle or object. The origin and destiny of a word or name is the total number of figures or digits of which the whole word or name is composed and is found by counting the number of figures you have used in the deduction. Thus: Adam, gross volume 4, four letters to spell Adam. Atomic weight value, 10; 1414 equals 10. Total digits, 141410, 6 digits used, plus 4 digits in Adam's name, equals 10; boils down to 1. The combined power of the name Adam is, therefore, 1, which is also the origin and destiny of the name Adam. Now take the word "dust," from

which Adam was created. Dust equals 4312 and the atomic weight value equals 10. This boils down to 1. One is the origin of Adam. Let's take the word "man," which was Adam's destiny. Man equals 415, equals 10. This again boils down to 1; therefore proving Adam's origin and destiny belong to the same family numeration as his name, which numerates 1. Adam was the first man; the figure 1 again. Now after God created Adam in His own image, he breathed into his nostrils the breath of life and man became a living soul, thereby Adam became the spirit of God.

$$\text{Spirit}=179992=37=10=1$$

This, again, boils down to 1; Adam, dust, man, being, spirit, mental image, infinite, power, perfect, Eden, heaven, paradise, fourth dimension, vitality, male-female, comprehension, power of intuition, initiative, knowledge of the soul, law of infinite wisdom, bosom, body, do, dare, purity, nuclei, protoplasm, equilibrium—all these words boil down to 1 and scientifically indicate and show the human path of destiny, by the application and rules of Numerology. We can trace the elements in the physical world from the absolute substance to where they became lost to all trace of human consciousness and blend with the great infinite realm of nuclei, the principles of life, the secret of spirit revealed.

LESSON (4)

Every human brain contains the same thinking substance. Numerology, I believe, will assist in organizing the brain cells of anyone who will apply earnestly to its study. When applied to names of people, Numerology discloses the temperament of the person through the signature he or she uses. Not only will Numerology scientifically indicate and show the human path of destiny, but will enable one to base a theory that the name of any thing, place, circumstance, law or principle can be truthfully analyzed and understood by its application.

The name of a person should be signed so that the atomic weight digit is the same as the soul number, when possible. The soul number is obtained by adding the entire number of digits comprising the month, day of month and the year born.

Thus: 2-6-1930

21 totals 3. A child born this day will have a soul number 3 and it depends upon the name given it whether it will have a Negative or a Positive temperament. Let us suppose that Mr. and Mrs. White are blessed with a charming baby girl. Born the 6th day of February, 1930, this child will possess a number 3 soul number. If I were called upon, I would name this child

Marie Eline White
41995 53955 58925

84=12 boils down to 3 in perfect tune with her soul vibration. The alphabetical construction of this name would give her 12 Positive letters that boil down to 3, which is her soul number, also her destiny number. The atomic weight value of this signature, 84, divided by the gross volume, 15, letters which boil down to 6, will give her a number 7 Positive temperament. The 12 Positive letters reduced to digits will give an atomic weight value 70. This boils down to 7, in tune with her temperament. Seven plus three. Her soul number thus equals 10, which equals 1, her personality number, which is the atomic weight value of Marie. Should she be called Marie Eline, she still will have a personality number 1; intellectual, earnest, virtuous, concordant words in tune with her personality number. Her soul path number (3) would contact her with these melody words: Noble, happy, self-reliant, thoughtful and intuitive. Her temperament, which would be 7 Positive, would attract her to the vocations sculptor, private secretary, diet specialist, naturopathic physician. Seven is the trinity of ex-

pression and manifests dignity, pride, just, harmonious, far-sighted and loving. And through her soul path and destiny number, in her twenty-first year she should be very happy as a **wife** and **mother**.

LESSON (5)

NUMEROLOGY, when thoroughly understood, will impart to the mind of humanity a clear comprehension of the principle of truth in all its manifestations and expressions, and give man wisdom to apply the law of creative thought to all things material and spiritual. By well-calculated thoughts and action, will power is developed. Will power is refined gray matter or nuclei—nuclei is spirit of man made perfect, always intellectually functioning through universal vibration. Numerology is the key of all knowledge of how to tune in on Positive or Negative vibration.

The alphabetical construction of your name bespeaks your temperament. Acquire, accomplish, advance, accumulation, Holy Bible, Nazarene, Christ, sacred, virtue, benediction, heaven, liberty, love, paradise, psychology, Numerology, human, happy, intelligence, peace, man, woman, child, home, church, fame, just, law, mother, virgin, you and your are all Positive words suggesting Positive vibration, creative, uplifting and beneficial to society; while a Negative temperament is contacted with turmoil and uncertainty, full of vituperation and sarcasm, hatred, unbelief, quarrelsome, sinful, selfish, insincere, mean, changeable, careless, fickle, lazy, cowardly, evil, traitors, sneaky and shiftless.

My dear readers, the knowledge of Numerology is of much worth, which will enable you to know the infinite power of the spirit that inhabits your body and gives you wisdom to control your thoughts, plus actions.

Let's take our lesson Five from the Holy Bible, and read the fifth verse of the seventeenth chapter of Genesis: "God spoke unto Abram, saying: Neither shall thy name any more be called Abram, but thy name is Abraham; for a father of many nations have I made thee.

By adding the letters A and H to Abram's name (A is the first letter of the alphabet, H is the eighth letter of the alphabet, a Negative and a Positive digit) one plus eight equals nine, the complete number, tuning Abraham in on universal soul and God vibration, which created in Abraham a Positive temperament. Now let's read the fifteenth and the sixteenth verses of the seventeenth chapter of Genesis: "And God said unto Abraham: As for Sari, thy wife, thou shalt not call her name Sari, but Sarah shall her name be. And I will bless her . . . and she shall be a mother of nations; kings of people shall be of her."

Think, dear readers; Abram was 99 years of age and Sari was 90 years of age when they changed their names to Abraham and Sarah and tuned in with the God vibration and so became the foundation of the mighty tribes of Israel.

Example—**Abram**

12914—The three positive digits 1, 9, 1, the atomic weight value totals 1, plus 9, plus 1, equals 11, equals 2, which reduces the Positive weight value of Abram to 2, a **Negative digit** creating a Negative temperament. Now the total weight value of **Abraham**

1291814—The atomic value of the Positive letters reduced to digits are 1, plus 9, plus 1, plus 1, equals 12, equals 3, creating a Positive temperament. Now let's take the Negative letters reduced to digits: 2 plus 8 plus 4 totals 14 and equals 5, the melody number of Christ, the Son of God. Now the total atomic weight value of the Negative and Positive digits, 1, the name Abraham, totals 26, and equals 8, concordant with God happiness and success. Now you will find by analyzing the name **Sari**

1199—four Positive digits, un-

evenly constructed, so Positive that it reduces to 1 plus 1, plus 9, plus 9, equals 20, equals 2. Now change the name to Sarah

11918=12=3—the Positive letters reduce to 3 Positive temperament predominating, plus the letter H reduced to the figure 8, plus the 3 Positive majority gross volume, reduces Sarah physical to 11, equals 2, true to the laws of nature—man Positive, woman Negative. There are sixty-three characters in the Bible who changed the spelling of their names and created Biblical history by tuning in on Positive vibrations through Positive names. Christ changed the spelling of the names of seven of His Apostles that they might possess Positive names and qualify to carry on their life's work, and make Biblical history. Read your Bible, dear readers, for there beams forth from every page a most blessed assurance that Numerology, as modernly discovered and interpreted, existed in the ancient days, and they, the writers of that period, inspired by God knew the value of this mathematical principle and used the four basic principles of Numerology to construct sentences based upon the true relation of words to each other in the harmonious numerical vibration of each syllable. The proof of this is the fact that the Holy Bible language is conceded the most perfect expression of thought existing as well as a complete understanding of the divine presence of God, assuring His unlimited powers and infinite wisdom. Numerology, when universally accepted, will restore the Holy Bible to its rightful place in the world, as the Word of God, divinely inspired and supremely authoritative work.

Dear readers, Numerology teaches me to look for the good in all I contact with, Negative or Positive. Ignorance is more destructive than war. Everything has to have a beginning. In the first chapter of Genesis, the beginning of the Holy Bible it says, "God created the heavens and the earth." Now we are going to see what the heavens and the earth numerate:

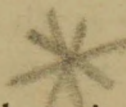

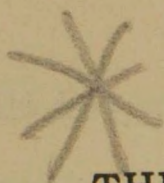

Numerology Reveals the Great Definition

WISDOM

Wisdom is right understanding; a faculty of discerning good from evil; what is to be chosen and what rejected; judgment grounded upon the value of things, and not the common opinion of them; an equality of force and resolution. It informs us upon all the duties of life, piety to our parents, faith to our friends, charity to the miserable, judgment in council; it gives us peace by fearing nothing, and riches by coveting nothing. There is no condition of life that excludes a wise man from discharging his duty. If his fortune be good he tempers it; if bad he masters it; if he has an estate he will exercise his virtue in plenty; if none in poverty. She searches NATURE, gives LAWS to LIFE and tells us that "IT IS NOT ENOUGH TO KNOW GOD UNLESS WE OBEY HIM." She looks upon all so-called accidents as the acts of providence; sets a true value upon things; delivers us from false opinions, and condemns all pleasures that are attended with repentance. She allows nothing to be good that will not

be so forever; no man to be happy but he that needs no other happiness but what he has within himself; no man to be great or powerful that is not MASTER OF HIMSELF; and this is the felicity of human life; a felicity that can neither be corrupted nor extinguished.

Soul Number Cycles

In the following Soul Number Interpretation

When one considers the unlimited number of combinations of figures which may produce any digit, one can see that, not in the **digit** is to be found the true analysis, but in the way **that digit is built**.

It must be remembered that the description of number-values following are general in their character; that they apply to number only and that only by careful analysis of the way the Melody is built can you expect to be sure of conclusions. Study the rules and principles laid down.

Words and phrases in the following interpretations which are in quotations will be found to reveal a Melody of the Soul Number under discussion.

ONE

Pioneer

The first number in the trinity of Acquisition, symbolized by the figure "1", is indicative of a mentality which is independent and self-sufficient. Precedent is not venerated. Self is sacrificed to gain experience and blaze the trail for others to follow. Expression is the same on all planes.

"Initiative," "Analysis," "Logic." Danger from "Insincerity." They stand alone and carve their own careers—do their own thinking and demand respect for their opinions.

Color—Flame. The color of pine wood burning. A light in dark places. Also lilac and crimson.

Music note—C. Tree—Walnut. Study of "body," slow to arrive at maturity but longlived and substantial; the roots

travel far when necessary to maintain "vitality." Flower—Lilac. The odor (influence) is strong and known in many lands. Thrives best in temperate climes. Mineral—Copper. Lacking the scintillating flash of gold, but a wonderful alloy for strengthening less substantial metals. Gem—Aquamarine and turquoise. Symbol—Torch.

TWO

Mechanic, Tabulator, Author

Producers on the physical plane, they are not fitted to stand alone; they depend upon others to lead and sometimes for their ideals. They are satisfied to work in the "Vineyard of the Lord," creating wealth for the race. They are influenced by their environment and themselves to conditions more readily than people who are concordant with other Numbers.

They nourish and care for the seed which others have planted, reaping the harvest and often keeping for themselves only a fraction. They have the faculty of presenting ideas clearly and cleverly with the pen and a mental type of 2 often will be found in concord with the vocation number of "Author," "Tabulator," "Stenographer." When "Ambition," "Force" and "Energy" are sufficiently indicated a 2 may progress from "Law Stenographer" to "Superior Court Judge."

Color—Gold, white, yellow, violet, black, (11). Mineral—Gold. Needs strengthening by association with firmer metals (iron or copper) to render greatest service. They can make "iron" their metal if they are willing to accept the refining process of "fire" experience. Musical note—D. Tree—Maple. "As the twig is bent the tree will grow" is not more true of any tree than of the maple. Flower—Violet. The number 2 loves all flowers and music, but flowers are not such an important element in the life of a 2 as is the case with some other numbers. They choose flowers which vibrate by name number (melody) to that which is needed to strengthen them and help in their life work. The gem should be chosen in the

same way. Gem—Sapphire, garnet, jade (11). Symbol—Cross. Denoting “service and sacrifice.” Danger—“Brutality.” The “lips” of the number 2 indicate much to the analyst. Thick lips—“generosity” and “loyalty”; thin lips—a “miserly” disposition.

THREE

Freedom

In their positive expression, “entertainer” and “joy-giver.” “Adaptability” makes them agreeable and lovable. “That smile that won’t come off” is characteristic of the positive 3.

Others build the homes; the three fill them with “cheer.” Welcome always in the sick-room because they scatter cheer.

“Art” and “literature” find many devotees in this vibration. Their danger is “greed” and “fear.” Commercial art, Electrical work, etc., are concordant vocational words.

Color—Gold flame, rose-red and sometimes amber. Musical note—E. Tree—Mahogany. Beautiful in any surrounding. Flower—Rose and pansy. Delicate and easily shattered (feelings easily hurt) but bright and happy when not suppressed. Also orchid and for-get-me-not. Mineral—Radium. Containing a subtle energy which may be healing, but destructive when wrongly used. Gem—Ruby and amethyst. Requiring very little encouragement to bring out their sparkle. Sardonyx and amber. Symbol—Wreath. 1, 2, 3 are the numbers of the “Trinity of Acquisition”; 3—“Physical expression.”

FOUR

Mind

Indicating a respect and veneration for things of the mind and development of mentality. “Efficiency,” “oratory,” “talker.”

They are in the race for intellectual and physical “supremacy” and accept “the survival of the fittest” as their law. They “work” “hard” for their money and appreciate the

value of it, especially so when indicated as of the osseous type. Their animal force is expressed with mental control.

"Work" is likely to become a "habit" which is difficult to abandon at the age when others seek to enjoy the fruits of a life of labor. "Judgment" and "sagacity" may be found concordant words for psychological description.

Color—Blue and green. "Grass, air and sky" blending to carry them high on the plane of intellectuality, also indigo, terra cotta and cream (22). Musical note—F. Tree—Hemlock. Its roots are firmly established in the physical world, while its branches reach the sky. "Practicability." Flower—Fuchsia. A sturdy fighter for its place in the sun, also columbine, goldenrod and daisy (22). Mineral—Silver. Not readily tarnished. Its fields of service are many. Gem—Bloodstone, emerald and moonstone. Symbol—Star and cube. Standing four-square to the world, never hiding its light under a bushel.

FIVE

Development

Five indicates a cycle of development. Standing in the middle of the Holy Trinity of Nine, the 5 is "manifesting in physical form for 'experience'." In their quest for experience they will "try anything new" and in this quest they are faithful. They are not cast down by failure but keep seeking that which is different. They have the pleasant personality and a "quick wit" which makes them pleasing to the opposite sex.

They have a "do as you please" consciousness which never can be crushed.

Fives will work if necessary; but it seldom is necessary, as their necessities usually come to them with but little effort. This is especially true when the name reveals less than an average presence of the 4 vibration.

They have but little comprehension of the rights of others, thinking first of their "own pleasure." They often seem selfish, though this is not the correct interpretation of the out-

ward indication; thoughtless is more nearly true. Marriages usually are made early, broken and repeated.

Five is the melody of "transmutation" and contains possibilities for either "high" or "low" "development." It is the melody vibration of "Christ," "life" and "good."

Color—Pink. Which develops a consciousness in its positive expression of "a sexless love." This color will help, if visualized in its purity, to transmute desire for "physical sex sensation" into "poise consciousness." Musical note—G. Should be kept in mind as a tone value which vibrates to "Divine life." Tree—Cherry and beech. Flower—Carnation, primrose and mignonette. Mineral—Clay. Should be used to mould "life" of "mental beauty." Gem—Olivine and pyrope. Symbol—triangle. Should be held in mind with the apex up.

This is one of the most difficult vibrations for the analyst to interpret and more than usual care should be taken that hasty conclusions be avoided. Organizers and managers, Executives and transportation wizards are found in this vibration. "Dream," "aspiration," "anticipation," "attempt," "undaunted" are a few of the words found to vibrate to a melody of 5, as well as "power." Often the 5 person is endowed with the "intuition" and "power" to make a "dream" come true.

SIX

Order

Six is the expression number of the Trinity of Development. Six may indicate either action or expression—the manifestation being revealed only by its relationship with action of expression numbers. In the word "do" it indicates action as it brings an action number into expression. In the word "fool" it has nothing to express but expression, as no action number is associated with it in the notes used to produce the word.

Six is the melody of the words "people," "person," "individuality," "conceit." It is concordant with all number and

will endeavor, in its positive manifestation, to establish "order" in its environment.

The 6 person is usually a "cheerful worker," "teacher," "banker," "broker." These people direct and guide the footsteps of all preceding numbers if permitted to do so. They feel and express the possession of "knowledge" and are now busy sorting and distributing it. Out of their past experience they draw, unconsciously, from the field of the unknown and often are possessed of the gift of "second sight." They are the best loved and best understood among the nine melody vibrations revealed in names.

Color—Scarlet and orange. Scarlet being preferred by those whose names reveal physical symbols above the average ratio of 5—4—3, while orange will appeal where mental or spiritual symbols exceed or equal the ratio. Also heliotrope. Musical note—A. Tree—Palm and rosewood. Flower—Chrysanthemum. Giving its beauty to the world in many shades and colors; tuberose and heliotrope. Mineral—Borax. In the commercial world borax is a cleanser and is used in the fusing of other metals. Gems—Diamond, topaz, jasper and onyx. Symbol—Crescent.

"Home-making" is the usual expression of the 6 in the world of form and this tendency may be looked for in some phase of manifestation; when circumstances or conditions prevent home-making for "self" the "altruistic" mentality of the positive 6 will lead to its expression for others, either in "financial" ways as a "educator," "architect" on the mental or physical plane, or as "priest," "evangelist" in the spiritual expression of the number, manifesting the faculty of "veneration" in the latter case. "Justice," "allegiance," "moderation" are words which may be expected in expression in the lives of the number 6 people.

SEVEN

Direction

Seven is the first in the Trinity of Expression. These people feel the urge for expression and service, but often lack

the confidence in self to push forward in response to it; thus the 7 person is likely to be "serious," "silent," "secretive," waiting to be asked or approached rather than to have his advances repelled. "Rabbit" vibrates to 7 in melody and in the word is found a double multiple of the 2 vibration indicating caution, into complete expression. The word "humble" also illustrates the more spiritual manifestation of the 7 vibration. The word "temerity" often is used to express a psychological aspect of the 7.

Care must be exercised by the analyst, however, that conclusions regarding the person whose name reveals 7 in melody be not hastily drawn. The word "valiant" vibrates to the 7 melody also. Study these two words and note the difference in their construction, then realize what care is needed to note the way a melody of a name is built before decisions are ocean of life with its cargo of service, **we must stand on our record.**

Before, and during every voyage, the wise skipper studies his charts for the currents and the winds he may encounter and his course accordingly. But in life, the wise skipper studies his HARBOR and strives to **direct the winds of desire** so as to carry him to the Port which The Master has directed.

No skipper may have charge of a ship until he has studied in the school of experience and has demonstrated his ability in minor activities.

In the school of Karmic Commerce, this is not our first voyage and it will not be our last and we must strive to have the log of our Ship of Dreams prove that we have wisely directed our actions to the end of Progress, holding constantly in our minds the Hope of a better ship, of a more valuable cargo and a more beautiful harbor, maintaining that Faith which will give them to us.

Many skippers there are, sailing, sailing, sailing, knowing not their harbor; unable to read their ships papers; making no effort to control the winds of their desires. When, and where, will they land their cargo? How will the log of their voyage of life read?

The number 7 person usually manifests "dignity," "compassion," "pride" and often "eloquence," once the wall of physical reserve is broken down.

The words "hot," "cold," "heat" and "temperature" all reduce to a melody of 7 and the person of this vibration may appear "cold" in outward expression though the "heat" of the inner self remains a "hidden physical power" or "hidden spirituality."

"Vision" and "will-power," "honor" and "honesty," "discernment" and "direction" may be looked for as manifesting beneath the surface in the "positive" 7 person.

They have the ability to "plan" and the gift of "direction" but often find it difficult to induce others to co-operate with them, due to the psychology of the seven, which few are able to understand.

They subconsciously are recognized by all with whom they come in contact for their wealth of secret information. Others feel their power to serve and so the pathway to the doorway of the number 7 individual is well trodden by troubled souls seeking advice, for whom the 7 always seems to know the world of encouragement which sends them on their way better equipped to continue the battle of life.

They are alone in the world and often prefer to be alone, even in the midst of throngs, remaining apart.

Their concord with "nature" and "earth" makes them good "farmers." "Wife," "mother," "sculptor" are words often found concordant.

Color—Purple, brick, steel. Purple is the mysterious color of "psychic power." "Steel" is symbolic of firmness of character and "Brick" is the solid foundation of red, ever ready and seeking to ascend into universal expression. Musical note—B. Tree—Fern. Beautiful but undemonstrative, growing and developing in quiet places. Flower—Geranium, poppy and hyacinth. Mineral—Platinum. Which does not readily corrode or burn when used as a contact point for electrical currents. Gem—Agate. It contains within itself a mystery

which the race has never fathomed. Also pearl. Symbol—Heart. With the triangle apex down.

EIGHT

Builder

Eight conveys the idea of "Master-Mind," indicating, for those whose Name Melody is 8, the possibility of achievement of mastership in their physical and intellectual endeavors.

Eight may overcome obstacles as a tornado scatters bundles of grain in the field through which it passes (providing it contacts the earth and does not waste its power in the air).

"Daring" is a natural characteristic. As "Builder" or "Creator" the 8 "Achieves" "Independence" and "Success" through "Learning" by "Application" and "Action."

Builders of railroads, of cities and of nations, they often fail to realize the misery which their directing genius imposes upon others in the development and completion of their plans. They always can be a power in their environment.

Wealth comes to them naturally, but not through the work of their hands. They should seek inspiration through the "9" vibration, which they find it difficult to do because their "Keen," "Analytical" "Intellectuality" will demand proof of all things spiritual.

Color—Canary. Which contains the suggestion of the activity of the "1," hidden but ever ready to burst into action through expression. Also tan and bronze. Musical Note—The octave of C. This note will help them in co-operating with many other life melodies, especially the "1." Tree—Hickory. A hard wood, difficult to train, "Tough," with a "Physical Power" greater than any ordinary wood. Flower—Begonia and dahlia, also jonquil. Mineral—Mica. Not readily affected by external magnetic influence. Gem—Opal and scarab. The scarab brings a subtle power of "Success" which others recognize subconsciously and respond to. The "Mystic" is symbolized by these gems. Symbol—Eye.

NINE

Expression

Nine completes the trinity of "Expression." It is the melody of the word "Attainment" and this word reveals, with analysis, the symbol of "Service" and "Sacrifice" necessary to reach the heights of its expression. The number 9 is 3 times 3 and also the hidden multiple of all other number or of all number which is "Law."

"Expression" is the key-word of the person whose melody is 9. Nine is the melody of the word "Ego."

The 9 people always maintain a positive and definite influence in their communities, though they seldom remain for many years in one place. The person whose dominant vibration is "9," is nearly always addicted to "traveling."

The Nines express "Love" in a universal way, so long as "Lust" is not permitted to individualize their emotions and shatter their "Reason," leading their steps into the mire of "Immorality" (which is 3 times 3 of sex—12—3) and causing them to become "Lost in the Slough of Earth Vibration."

Color—Red. Symbolizing "Universal Impersonal Love." It is the color sometimes found in the silken sheen of a Persian rug, or buried deep in the heart of a Dahlia; combining the rose of the 3 with the scarlet of the 6 which symbolizes "Service" (36—9). Also brown and lavender. Musical Note—Octave D. Tree—Oak. They may choose as their ideal the great oak which commands respect, whether it is one of a forest or whether it stands majestically alone, or they may become as the "Scrub Oak," which litters the hillsides in so many landscapes. Flower—Holly and aster. Mineral—Nickel. Shining with a wonderful brilliance or becoming dark and lustreless from "Lack" of "Use." Gem—May be any one or all of the gems which belong to the 3 or 6 vibrations, or they may be combined. Symbol—Sun.

Numerical Astrology

- SCORPIO, from October 24 to November 22
- SAGITTAURUS, from November 23 to December 21
- CAPRICORN, from December 22 to January 20
- AQUARIUS, from January 21 to February 19
- PISCES, from February 20 to March 20

Knowing that the planets have an effect and that the seasons come and go without consultation, all we have to do is to learn the influence exerted by the planets and act accordingly. The heaviest rains always occur at from new to full Moon, and the heaviest snow from full to new Moon. Equinoctial storms occur a little late or a little early as the new Moon is a little before or after the time the Earth crosses the line.

A noted Author once said, "All good color is in some degree pensive and the purest and most thoughtful minds are those which love color most."

The effect of Color on Health, Wealth and Happiness is a subject of far more importance than can be imagined. Few people realize that colors affect them, but such is the fact.

Red

From experience it may generally be inferred that red is an undesirable color, for it places one at once under the dominion of Mars, which symbolizes warfare, quarrels, opposition. A bull is crazed by a red rag. Red is always the signal of danger. Red can be distinguished at a greater distance than any other. A red light can be seen further than any other.

People of a quick temper, restless, nervous, combative, or who have brain trouble, should avoid red. On the other hand, those lacking in vitality, energy, and persons of an uncertain nature or purpose will do well to wear lots of red. Red is tonic, excitant, stimulant, and signifies love, wisdom and loyalty.

Blue

This is a better color in many respects. Persons who wear lots of blue accomplish all things undertaken. They easily accumulate wealth and prominence. It is the color of true love, art, music, happiness. Blue is soothing, quieting and healthgiving. Blue signifies constancy and fidelity.

Yellow

This is the color of the sun, and of gold and denotes wealth, luxury, enjoyment, pleasure, faith, hope and charity. Yellow is a nerve animating, laxative color. Yellow brings brightness of disposition and optimism. A yellow house, sign or writing paper always inspires confidence and faithfulness.

Green

This is the color of vegetation and signifies abundance. Green means success only by persistent effort. It means peace, rest, repose and is the opposite to red. Persons who wear green generally keep in the background; they are quiet and have little to say. Green is used as a signal on railroads and ships to signify that everything is safe and all right to go ahead. Green signifies hope, victory and immortality.

White

This is a symbol of innocence, purity, light, energy, joy, clean and simple. Anything that is white is therefore good, chaste, healthful, natural, beneficial.

Black

Black corresponds to night and symbolizes the negative principle. Black represents inaction, death, the opposite of life and energy and is used as a fitting emblem of mourning.

Black should never be worn if it can be avoided (unless at night). Black affects the health badly; it is a devitalizing element; it takes the life or vitality out of a person; it affects the mind with sadness. Black takes all the joy and gladness out of life. Black acts against success, repelling all that is good, and creates adversity. Black means poverty, sickness, death and denotes extravagance, the opposite to economy.

Purple

From the most ancient times purple has been associated with all that is royal, kingly, splendid, elevated, noble, great exalted and magnanimous. Purple is a lucky color to have about or to wear.

Violet

Signifies love, truth, passion and despair. In other respects violet is similar to purple.

Brown

Brown is the color that represents thought, study and intelligence. It is a quiet, astute and harmonious color. Brown harmonizes with most any color. Brown is warm, subdued and independent. Brown indicates capacity, perseverance, inspiration, reason, prudence and judgment. Persons who wear brown are generally healthy, long lived and happy; it is a good color and shows self-confidence.

Gray

This color is an emblem of Saturn, subdued, sober, determined, positive, hard and calculating. Beware of gray eyes, or the person who always wear gray clothes.

Checks

These represent broken conditions, disappointments, and denotes evil tendencies, the extent and strength of which is to be judged by the prevailing color.

Plaids

These denote eccentricities, vagaries, and are the most dangerous colors one can trifle with. The wearers of plaids

are always uneasy, unsettled, and usually poor. The prevailing colors give a clue to the mind and affairs.

Material

The materials of which one's clothes are composed should also be considered. The finer and more delicate the material the better the influence, and the farther one gets away from animal coverings the better for freedom of conditions. For this reason vegetable fabrics are better than wool. Silk is delicate and refined but not always healthy. Linen is preferable to cotton for clothing and cotton felt better than leather for shoes. *

A study of colors will show how we may aid ourselves in the matter of dress and thus better fit ourselves to achieve success, health, wealth and happiness.

PRACTICAL CHARACTER READING

If you know the weak and strong characteristics of people you will be able to control and influence them. Take heed to the following delineation, and the lives of people will be as open for you to read as a book. Character is plainly written in every man or woman's face, and he who looks may read. If every person knew this or realized this fact perhaps there would be more care taken to wipe out peevish and bad tempered lines or a sly, deceitful tilt of the eyelids. A polished villain often fools the shrewdest of men or women; a silver tongue with silver tact is quality that wins. But nature stamps her marks in various places upon the human form. Our thoughts manifest themselves through our nerves, causing the nervous system to play an important part in the recording of these marks upon form, head, face, palm and in the handwriting of an individual, making it an easy matter for one who makes human nature a study to distinguish the rogue from the gentleman or lady, also by looking in any person's face be able to tell what kind of character that individual has, and what they would be best suited for. Every feature is indicative of character. A club woman has different

features from a home maker. A suffragette could never by any chance be mistaken for a musician. Every feature has its significance; the color of the eyes, the tilt of the nose and the curve of the cheek, each has a meaning all of its own. Every living face is a bulletin board of thought, moulded first by inherited character and thereafter by the thoughts and passions that most often move that face to expression.

The muscles that are moved by hatred, anger, benevolence, wisdom, courage, etc., develop or contract certain muscles in the face. The muscles thus affected by the most frequently recurring thoughts becomes shrunken or developed, as the case may be.

The Eyes—Dark brown or black eyes denote an impetuous temperament, capable of great extremes of feeling, likes and dislikes, and passionate ardor in romantic love. Brown eyes denote those traits in a less intense degree, the temperament becoming more placid as the brown grows lighter. Of soft, dark brown eyes, take care; beware. An affectionate disposition, sweet and gentle, accompanies the russet brown eye which is not yellowish. Yellowish brown eyes denote an inconstant disposition, with little or no will power. The ideal of sublime purity of the affections is found in violet or dark blue eyes. Clear, light blue eyes, calm and tranquil, denote a cheerful, constant nature, with intellectual powers and the passions well balanced. Gray eyes denote intellect, always and everywhere. Pale blue eyes denote coldness and selfishness. Blue eyes with greenish tints accompany a predominance of the intellectual powers over the passions, a nature ruled by wisdom and sustained by a great moral courage, which may attain high position. Greenish gray eyes are the most intellectual, and if in them may be seen varying shades of blue and orange we find the strange mixture of the sour and the sweet, of optimism and pessimism, which produces the impressionable temperament of the genius. Eyes with a preponderance of greenish shade denote coquetry and the most artful deceitfulness. Eyes of dead color, dull and

expressionless, bespeak a sluggish temperament, listless disposition, and a cold, selfish nature with a critical attitude toward life. A calm, steadfast glance from a tranquil blue eye, usually large, denotes a clear conscience, sweet, gentle disposition and generous nature. Hazel eyes that light up frequently and sparkle with life denote a fickle disposition. The greater width between the eyes the more susceptible and impressionable the intellect. Eyes set close together are not to be trusted, they mean the kind of stupidity that goes with sly wickedness, accompanying the obtuse, obstinate nature.

The smaller the eyes the greater the extremes of feeling of which the owner is capable. Large eyes denote calmness, constancy and patience. Eyes deeply set denote determination, courage, and gentility. Bulging eyes denote culture, refinement, yet sometimes a selfish, harsh temperament.

The Hair—Dark hair denotes great bodily strength, wiry muscles and an energetic, determined and persevering character. Light hair denotes a lively character, genial, versatile, impulsive and notes a character marked by vividness of conception, intensity of emotion, liveliness of imagination and refinement of tastes.

The Head—A relatively large head denotes a great mental temperament. A broad head denotes great courage. A small head denotes a delicate temperament. A narrow head is that of a coward.

The Chin—A receding chin shows weakness of character. It is a sign of people who give up easy and allow others to overbear them. A pointed chin is a sign of peevish, fretful disposition, without strength, but vixenish, with a marked tendency toward teasing and have ideals which are not easily satisfied. A narrow chin denotes congenial love, a love exactly adapted for oneself. A dented chin is found with a temperament that desires to be loved and are people who hunger for affection and are miserable without some one to care for them. A broad round chin denotes devoted attraction, often accompanied by jealousy and distrust, yet is a person benevo-

lent and charitable, also shows a lasting affection and esteem, self control and a determined will power. A square chin indicates a stubborn disposition and firm decision.

The Mouth—Large mouths are indicative of more character than small ones.

The Lips—Full lips are a sign of an affectionate disposition, thin lips of the reverse. The weak person does not close the lips firmly, the lower lip is pendulous and loose. Coarse, irregularly formed lips indicate strength, hospitality, jealousy, also firmness. A long upper lip denotes a natural born whiner and nagger of the unpleasant, useless and helpless kind, while a short upper lip with a cupid's bow shows a fickle nature.

The Nose—A pointed nose, as everyone practically knows, denotes a prying disposition. Beware of the person with this feature, as they will never rest until they know your business. The Roman nose indicates executiveness, one who conquers; warriors, statesmen and other famous men and women of all ages have had noses of the Roman Type. The Greek nose denotes refinement, artistic taste and great love of the beautiful things agreeable to their tastes. The haw, or Jew nose, indicates commercialism, worldly shrewdness, insight into character and ability to turn this insight to a profitable account. The pug or snub nose has made no legible mark on the record of this world's progress. Napoleon said no person with a short nose ever amounted to much of anything. It is certain that the majority of those who have succeeded have rather prominent noses. Large fleshy nostrils are a sign of money getting and holding.

Laughter—Laughter is another indication of character. Those who seldom laugh but often smile indicates depth of character, intensity of feeling, and thoughtfulness, also self-control. The frequent giggler denotes a shallow thinker. The coarse, loud laughter denotes rudeness combined with contempt. Nearly everyone has his or her method of reading character. demand of you who is to become the father or mother of your children? "Whatsoever a man soeth, that shall he also reap." Our life is just what we make it through thought forces.

All things in this world produce after their own order. We cannot gather grapes from thorn bushes nor pick figs from thistles. Physical transgressions provoke physical disorders, and mental transgressions produce mental disorders. Physical ills are the results of physical sins. Poisoned minds are caused by unkind thoughts daily harbored.

Our destiny is in our own power. We are not hopeless creatures of circumstances. We can be what we will be, but only by holding ourselves to consistent and well-calculated thoughts and actions. As we become drunkards by so many drinks of liquor so do we become saints in the moral spheres by so many kind and considerate acts and good thoughts. By always being on the alert, measuring and estimating our opportunities so as to make every act and word tell upon a predetermined result.

By practice do we become perfect. It is only in the doing of good things that will lead us to happiness. Trust thyself and you will never have cause to mistrust. There is something wrong with the individual who is mistrustful of every person whom they meet. The man or woman of doubts follow a path both rough and hard. If you are unhappy you have sinned. Make amends and start life anew. Be born again and so think and live to earn success.

DR. VALJIEN'S GRAPHOLOGICAL CHART AND CHARACTER DELINEATION

Diplomacy—A diplomat is one who is secretive, reserved, cunning, crafty, and evasive; you can not corner him. Lawyers are usually quite diplomatic. The men who control and shape the affairs of governmental policies are diplomats. This is a good quality to possess if used in the right direction. One having a high percentage of diplomacy should seek to develop all the qualities that make the diplomat, and strive to get into a position where he will be able to make this quality pay.

Tact—This is a quality essential to success where one is constantly dealing with masses of people. A salesman without tact is a failure. A tactful person has good conversational ability, a pleasing manner, and always a ready excuse. To win the friendship and esteem of others you should be tactful. Scientific flattery is used by the tactful person, and he always finds a way to gain his point or obtain an audience. Such a person is adapted to salesmanship, real estate, promotion of corporations, etc. Coupled with sufficient diplomacy, force and ambition, success in almost any undertaking is sure to follow.

Acquisition—A high percentage of this quality is an attribute desirable. Coupled with other good characteristics, it brings success. If you are lacking in the desire and power of acquisition, you should start immediately to develop it. Russell Sage, Andrew Carnegie, and many others who are rich attribute their great wealth to their desire of acquiring, first pennies, then dollars. It signifies economy, thrift, frugality, and a desire to own and maintain. Persons with good powers of acquisition are most adapted for banking and the handling of finance.

Will Power—Where one is lacking in firmness, others are sure to take advantage of him, not only in business, but in all affairs. If the percentage is low, you should strive to cultivate a strong will power, as it gives perseverance, stability, and

decision of purpose. This can be done through auto-suggestion. Persons who have a high percentage of will power make good superintendents, disciplinarians, and are capable of managing help. Large corporations, factories, and stores employ for the heads of their various departments people with strong will power, but they must also possess enough tact and magnetism to keep them from being obstinate.

Force—This quality signifies combativeness, courage, snap, efficiency, defiance, determination; a love of encounter and a desire to defend. Dewey's high percentage of force, also diplomacy, accounts for his being the general and fighter. Most prize fighters have a high percentage of this quality, but are lacking in nearly all other qualities, hence the prize fighter. Persons with a high percentage of this quality are best adapted to positions where they may be called upon at any time to use it. Policemen, guards, watchmen, and athletes all possess a high percentage of force. But when this quality is largely developed and the intellectual faculties also show a high percentage, it signifies that the person is adapted for a higher calling. Roosevelt's force, but other qualities as well, made him the great leader and diplomat.

Secrecy—Persons who lack secretiveness would make poor detectives. Those having a high percentage of this quality would make excellent servants for the government. Would also make good conjurors, sleight-of-hand performers, magicians. The desire to be tricky, evasive, and cunning fits one for all positions where double-dealing and management are called for. All diplomats are very secretive. It is a good quality when counter-balanced with honesty and a desire to be just.

Magnetism—One who is magnetic is agreeable, pleasant, polite, and usually has power to persuade. This is the much sought quality and should be cultivated. It costs nothing to be magnetic and is the means of gaining friends and coveted positions. Magnetic persons succeed where those far more qualified for certain positions fail. If you lack magnetic quali-

ties, your first duty should be to cultivate agreeableness, blandness, complaisance, suavity and the habit of being polite to everybody. A study of the law of suggestion and systems of self-treatment by auto-suggestion will develop personal magnetism. It remains for you to cultivate it. It qualifies you for a better position in life.

Psychic—Most psychic individuals are prophetic and are capable of forewarning what is to be. Some are even possessed of second sight. Intuition and spirituality is largely developed in those who have a high percentage of psychic force. If this quality is largely indicated, it should be cultivated to the highest possible degree. It opens many avenues for money making. Character reading and the ability to advise others regarding the future is the line of work most profitable to those who possess a high percentage of psychic power.

Expression—One gifted with a high percentage of the power of expression should be adapted to positions where convincing argument wins success. Most literary writers have the power of expression. Orators, public speakers, and teachers possess it to a great degree. Where the indications from one's character show a fair percentage of this power, every effort should be made to perfect it, and the positions above mentioned sought.

Intuition—If a person has a high percentage of intuition, it indicates power of inductive reasoning; perception of truth, discernment of characters and motives; intuitive reading of men and conditions by minor signs. Such persons make good doctors and healers, as well as readers of character. If the percentage is sufficiently high, the person should study to become a physician. It depends upon the percentage of other characteristics, as to how successful, as a physician, one would be. Concentrated effort in any one direction promotes efficiency.

Computation—The mathematician has great powers of computation; usually a good memory and the ability to reckon figures mentally. If the percentage is high, the person is

adapted to accounting, bookkeeping, etc., and should strive to become an expert by concentrated effort in this direction. There is always a demand for accountants and it depends entirely upon the efficiency of the person as to the kind of position obtainable. Construction—Persons with powers of constructing should devote their concentrated energies to all things mechanical. If the percentage is high, coupled with other good characteristics, such as powers of expression, tact, and magnetism, the person should be a preacher. If lacking in these qualities the person would be successful as a nurse. Where kindness is largely developed, generosity is indicated. There is such a thing, however, as being generous to a fault, which is a detriment to success. If the power of acquisition is well developed, together with kindness, it indicates that the person is very magnetic.

Mirth—The funmaker; the actor usually has a high percentage of this quality; has a perception of the absurd and ridiculous, and a disposition to joke; is full of wit and humor; is sarcastic and ever ready with a comment on anything improper or unbecoming. If the percentage is sufficiently high, success upon the stage awaits the individual.
